

2020 Roland Garros: R64 Quick Hits

Country Breakdown

A total of 39 different countries were represented in the draw this year at Roland Garros. Players from 30 different countries advanced to the second round in Paris, including eight Americans, six from the Czech Republic and five from both Romania and Russia.

Mexican qualifier Renata Zarazua defeated French wildcard Elsa Jacquemot in the opening round becoming the first Mexican to win a main draw match since 2000 Australian Open when Angelica Gavaldon advanced to the second round after defeating Tzipora Obziler.

Zarazua is the first Mexican to appear in the main draw at Roland Garros since 1995 (Gavaldon) and first to win a main draw match at Roland Garros since 1994 (Gavaldon, 2r).

Danish qualifier Clara Tauson advanced to the second round with her win over American Jennifer Brady. Tauson is just the third Dane to win a main draw match at Roland Garros in the last 32 years joining Caroline Wozniacki and Tine Scheuer-Larsen.

Qualifier Nadia Podoroska is the first player from Argentina to reach the 2r at Roland Garros since Paula Ormaechea in 2014; Ormaechea advanced to the third round.

2020 Roland Garros: R64 Quick Hits

Seed Breakdown

The seeds posted a 20-12 record in the opening days of the tournament.

Nine of the Top 10 seeds have advanced to the second round, the first time at Roland Garros since 2015.

In total, with only 20 seeds through to the second round, it is the fewest to advance to the second round at Roland Garros since the field expanded to 32 seeds in 2000. Further it is the fewest seeds to advance to the second round of a Slam since 2016 Australian Open.
