- One of the five pre-Australian Open tournaments and the second to be staged in Adelaide, following the WTA 500 event won by Ashleigh Barty on Sunday
- Barty also lifted the doubles title last week, alongside compatriot Storm Sanders
- The No.1 seed this week is a Wild Card recipient, **Aryna Sabalenka**, who joins the tournament following a second-round loss to Kaja Juvan at the Adelaide International. She will face a qualifier in her opening match
- Another player to fall at the first hurdle at Memorial Drive last week was **Elina Svitolina**, she also returns for the WTA 250 as the No.2 seed and faces **Madison Keys** first up
- **Coco Gauff** is the No.3 seed and looks to build on her second round showing here last week, when she led by a set and a break before eventually being edged out by Barty
- One to Watch Jasmine Paolini ended last year just outside of the Top 50, at No.53, thanks to a WTA125 Series win and the Portoroz title. She upset four seeds at the latter, including Alison Riske, who she could possibly face in the semifinals this week. The Italian also finished 2021 strongly on hard courts, reaching the last four at Courmayeur, quarterfinals at Linz and coming through qualifying to make the third round at Indian Wells
