- The Hologic WTA Tour returns to Eastbourne for its 48th edition
- Headlining the field is defending Wimbledon champion and World No.3 **Elena Rybakina**. She is joined in the draw by fellow Top Five players **Jessica Pegula** and wildcard **Caroline Garcia**
- Also in the draw are last year's finalists at Eastbourne, **Petra Kvitova** and **Jelena Ostapenko**, who are set to face each other in the opening round. The two are not only the most recent Eastbourne champions, with Ostapenko lifting the title in 2021 (d. Kontaveit) and Kvitova in 2022 (d. Ostapenko), but are also the most recent grass court champions, with Kvitova winning Berlin and Ostapenko lifting the Birmingham trophy last week
- Rounding out the field are British wildcards **Katie Boulter**, who lifted her maiden title at Nottingham two weeks ago, and **Harriet Dart**, who made back-to-back quarterfinals at Nottingham and Birmingham this year

- Other notable matchups include Pegula taking on 2022's Newcomer of the Year **Zheng Qinwen** and 2023 Nottingham champion Boulter taking on 2023 Birmingham runner-up **Barbora Krejckova**
- *One to Watch* – **Anastasia Potapova**. The 2016 Wimbledon Girls Champion is having a breakthrough season, winning her second title at Linz (d. Martic in F) and reaching her first grass court semifinal at Birmingham (l. eventual champion Ostapenko in three sets). She sits at a career-high ranking of No.21 in the world, and with a successful run at Eastbourne could break into the Top 20 for the first time in her young career
