## TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

- This year marks the 25th staging of the Hungarian Grand Prix
- **Yulia Putintseva** and **Danielle Collins** lead the field this week as the No.1 and No.2 seeds, respectively. Both will face a qualifier in their opening round matches
- Hungary's No.1 **Timea Babos**, who won the Hungarian Ladies Open here in 2017, opens her 2021 Budapest campaign against No.6 seed **Aliaksandra Sasnovich**
- All main draw wildcards awarded to home nation players: **Dalma Galfi**, **Reka-Luca Jani** and **Panna Udvardy**
- *One to Watch* – **Ana Konjuh**. The former World No.20 is on the comeback trail after a series of injuries over the last few years. The Croatian started the season ranked No.477 and now sits at No.129 after reaching the round of 16 at Miami and a strong clay season, including a runner-up finish at Belgrade and quarterfinal run at Istanbul
