## TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

- Top seed **Yastremska** will get her campaign underway against the winner of Frech/Qualifier.
- No. 2 seed **Putintseva** awaits the winner of Friedsam/Petkovic.
- All main draw wildcards awarded to home nation players: **Niemeier, Korpatsch, and Barthel.**
- *One to Watch* – **Tamara Zidansek**. Recently reached her first Grand Slam semifinal at 2021 Roland Garros and became the first Slovenian player to do so. As a result, Zidansek broke into the Top 50 for the first time (career high No. 46 on June 21, 2021). She starts her campaign as the No. 3 seed against the winner of Bara/Kr. Pliskova.
