- The Teotihuacán Group features the only two players in the draw to have previously contested the tournament: former semifinalists **Karolina Plisková** and **Garbiñe Muguruza**
- Plisková** is contesting a fifth consecutive WTA Finals, advancing to the semifinals in her last three appearances
- Muguruza** is competing at a WTA event on Mexican soil for the fourth time in her career. The Spaniard owns a 10-1 main-draw record in the country, and returns defending a 10-match winning streak after lifting back-to-back titles at Monterrey in 2018 and 2019
- At 29 years old, 241 days (as of the end of the tournament), **Plisková** is the oldest participant in the singles draw
- Plisková** enters the WTA Finals with a tour-leading 364 aces to her name. In four of the past six seasons, the Czech has led the tour for aces struck
- Barbora Krejčíková** is also the top seed in the doubles draw alongside long-term partner Katerina Siniakova. It is the first time that a player qualified for both singles and doubles at the season-ending showpiece since Karolina Plisková in 2016
- Krejčíková** and **Plisková's** presence in the draw means that the Czech Republic has now been represented at every edition of the WTA Finals since 2011. The other qualifiers during this period were Petra Kvitová (2011-15, 2018-19) and Lucie Safarova (2015)
- Spain also has two representatives in the singles field, with Paula Badosa joining **Muguruza**. It is the first time that Spain has multiple players competing in the event, since Arantxa Sanchez Vicario and Conchita Martinez in 2000
- Krejčíková** is 13-2 in three-set matches in 2021 with her only losses coming to eventual champions Iga Swiatek at Rome and Belinda Bencic at the Olympics
- The form player in the field is **Anett Kontaveit**, who posted a 26-2 record in her final seven tournaments of the season, winning four titles. Prior to that stretch, the Estonian was 19-13 for the year and sat at No.30 on the Porsche Race to the WTA Finals Leaderboard. In her last two tournaments, Kontaveit collected her third and fourth titles of the season at Moscow and then Cluj-Napoca, thus overtaking Ons Jabeur to claim the final qualification spot
- Kontaveit** owns a Tour-leading 36 match wins on hardcourts this year (36-10)
- Both **Kontaveit** and **Krejčíková** are 39-2 this season in matches when they've captured the first set
- Two of the draw's three Grand Slam champions are in this group, in the form of **Muguruza** (2016 Roland Garros, 2017 Wimbledon) and **Krejčíková** (2021 Roland Garros). **Plisková** is a two-time major runner-up (2016 US Open, 2021 Wimbledon), while **Kontaveit's** best result across the four Slams is a quarterfinal run at the Australian Open in 2020

- Making singles debut at WTA Finals
- Accumulated 4518 points on the Porsche Race to WTA Finals leaderboard (the second most of the players in Guadalajara, behind Sabalenka on 4768)
- Contested doubles at WTA Finals twice, finishing R-Up in 2018 (l. Babos/Mladenovic) and falling in round robin in 2019 (both w/Siniakova)
- Also top seed in doubles draw in Guadalajara (w/Siniakova). Is the first woman to qualify for both singles and doubles at WTA Finals since Ka.Pliskova in 2016
- Faces No.8 Kontaveit today. Owns four Top-10 wins in her career, all coming this year: No.5 Kenin (Rome), No.6 Svitolina (Roland-Garros), No.9 Muguruza (Cincinnati) and No.10 Muguruza (US Open)
- Only previous match against an Estonian was a three-set win over Kanepi in 1r at 2020 Australian Open (her first career Grand Slam main-draw victory)
- Best career result on hard courts was this year's title run at Prague
- One of two Czech women in the draw (also Ka.Pliskova); the Czech Republic has now been represented at every edition of the WTA Finals since 2011
- Best results by Czech women at the WTA Finals were title runs from Novotna (1997) and Kvitova (2011)
- Is currently ranked No.3; ended last season at No.65
- Has won 44 main-draw matches this season - only Jabeur (48) and Kontaveit (45) have registered more
- Is 13-2 in three-set matches in 2021 with her only losses coming to eventual champions Iga Swiatek at Rome and Belinda Bencic at the Olympics

- Finished with 3096 points, after accumulating nearly a third of these in her past three tournaments: Indian Wells (215), Moscow (470) and Cluj-Napoca (280)
- Is the first Estonian woman to qualify for the WTA Finals
- Faces No.3 Krejciikova in her opening match today; owns four Top-10 wins this season, over No.4 Kenin (Stuttgart), No.7 Andreescu (Eastbourne), No.10 Kvitova (Ostrava) and No.5 Muguruza (Moscow)
- Owns two wins in her career over Top-3 ranked opponents: No.1 Kerber (2017 Rome) and No.2 Wozniacki (2018 Rome)
- Owns 13-17 career record against players from Czech Republic in main-draw matches, while is 4-2 this season (l. Kvitova at Doha and Vondrousova at Wimbledon; d. Siniakova at Cleveland, Kvitova at Ostrava and Siniakova and Vondrousova at Moscow)
- Record against higher-ranked opponents this season is 9-10
- Best career result on outdoor hard courts was title run at 2021 Cleveland. Also won indoor hard-court titles this season at Ostrava, Moscow and Cluj-Napoca
- Is currently ranked No.8, having broken into Top-10 for the first time following Cluj-Napoca title run (November 1, 2021)
- Posted a 26-2 record in her final seven tournaments of the season, winning four titles. Prior to that stretch, was 19-13 for the year and sat at No.30 on the Porsche Race to the WTA Finals Leaderboard
- Is currently on a 10-match winning streak, the longest tour-level run of her career
- Has won 45 matches so far in 2021, the second most on tour (behind Jabeur on 48)
- Owns a tour-leading 36 match wins on hard courts this year (36-10)

SEASON 2021 HISTORY

- Lost both singles rubbers (l. Bencic and Kerber) as Czech Republic failed to reach SF at Billie Jean King Cup Finals
 - Reached QF at Cincinnati (l. eventual champion Barty) and US Open (l. Sabalenka). Made R16 at Indian Wells (l. eventual champion Badosa)
 - Advanced to R16 in singles at Olympics (l. eventual champion Bencic) and won doubles gold medal w/Siniakova
 - Enjoyed R16 run at Wimbledon (l. eventual champion Barty), followed by title at Prague (d. Martincova in F)
 - At Roland Garros became the first woman since 2000 to sweep titles in singles (d. Pavlyuchenkova in F) and doubles (w/Siniakova); saved 1MP to beat Sakkari in SF
 - Began the clay court season with 2r showing at Istanbul (l. Bogdan), 1r exit at Madrid (l. Badosa) before lifting maiden WTA singles title at Strasbourg (d. Cirstea in F); also won doubles title in Madrid (w/Siniakova)
 - At Dubai, reached second career final (l. Muguruza). Then made 2r at Miami (l. Swiatek)
 - In doubles, won title at Gippstand Trophy and finished R-Up at Australian Open (both w/Siniakova). Also defended mixed doubles title at Melbourne Park (w/Ram)
 - Opened season with 2r showing at Abu Dhabi (l.Putintseva), before advancing to QF at Grampians Trophy (l. Brady) and then 2r at Australian Open (l. Alexandrova)
- Won back-to-back titles at Moscow (d. Alexandrova in F - trailed 6-4 4-0) and Cluj-Napoca (d. Halep in F)
 - At Ostrava, lifted second title of the season (d. Sakkari in F). Withdrew prior to 2r match at Chicago (w/left thigh injury) and then advanced to QF at Indian Wells (l. Jabeur)
 - Returned to form at Cleveland, lifting second WTA title of her career (d. Begu in F), followed by 3r run at US Open (l. Swiatek)
 - Fell 1r at the Olympics (l. Sakkari), Montréal (l. Pegula) and Cincinnati (l. Jabeur)
 - Enjoyed R-Up finish at Eastbourne (d. No.7 Andreescu in 2r, l. Ostapenko) before 1r exit at Wimbledon (l. Vondrousova)
 - Advanced to QF at Stuttgart (d. No.4 Kenin in 2r, l. Sabalenka), then fell 2r at Madrid (l. Sakkari) and 3r at Roland Garros (l. Swiatek)
 - Reached 3r at Dubai (l. Sabalenka) and Miami (l. Mertens)
 - Produced QF run at Doha (l. eventual champion Kvitova in 3s)
 - Posted 3r showing at Australian Open (l. Rogers) after reaching the Grampians Trophy final (the final was not played)
 - Opened 2021 season with 1r exit at Abu Dhabi (l. Kudermetova)

CAREER MILESTONES

- Lifted maiden WTA title at 2021 Strasbourg, followed by sweep of singles and doubles titles at Roland Garros. Roland Garros was just her fifth Slam main draw in singles; only two women have won a major with fewer main draw appearances to their name
- Enjoyed breakout year in singles in 2020, posting career-high ranking of No.65 (November 16) and making R16 at Roland Garros and reaching second WTA SF at Linz
- Also reached two doubles finals last year, finishing R-Up at Dubai (w/Zheng) and winning Shenzhen (w/Siniakova)
- In Mixed Doubles, defended Australian Open title (w/Pavic), having triumphed in Melbourne a year earlier with w/Ram
- In 2019, advanced to QF at Bucharest in addition to winning four ITF Circuit singles titles on clay in North America and Europe, winning 20 of her 21 matches during this stretch
- Also in 2019, posted second Top 20 doubles season highlighted by titles at Toronto and Linz, and R-Up finish at Indian Wells (all w/Siniakova). Won Australian Open mixed doubles title w/Ram
- In 2018, won first two Grand Slam trophies at Roland Garros (d. Hozumi/ Ninomiya in F) and Wimbledon (d. Melichar/Peschke in F) both w/Siniakova, the first pairing to complete the Roland Garros-Wimbledon double since Kim Clijsters and Ai Sugiyama in 2003; also became the first team ever to win the girls' (2013) and ladies' doubles title at SW19
- Rose to WTA doubles World No.1 on October 22, 2018
- Highlight of 2017 was R-Up finish in first WTA singles final at Nürnberg (l. Bertens in F). Also made QF as qualifier at Bastad (l. Garcia). Only other tour-level appearances were 1r exits at Bucharest and Québec City

- Jurak and Klepac have played 15 tournaments as partners this year – winning titles at Bad Homburg and San Jose and finishing R-Up at Parma and Montréal
- Their San Jose and Montreal finals came in back-to-back weeks in August
- They also made the SF stage at Chicago and the QFs at Roland-Garros
- This is Klepac's third appearance at the WTA Finals – she qualified in 2017 and 2018 with Martinez-Sanchez, however lost opening matches in both years. This is Jurak's first appearance at the WTA Finals
- The team first paired up back in 2006 on the ITF Circuit. They briefly reunited in 2014 before once again getting back together in 2021
- Jurak has been a fixture on the doubles circuit for over a decade now. In 2014 she lifted her first doubles title at Monterrey (w/Moulton-Levy) and seven more have followed, including at the WTA 500 tournaments at Dubai (w/Chuang) and Eastbourne in 2016 (w/An.Rodionova). She owns a 9-12 record in finals
- Jurak has taken her game to new heights in 2021, winning two WTA titles and making her Grand Slam breakthrough, reaching SF at Australian Open w/Stojanovic and QF at Roland Garros w/Klepac. She currently sits at a career-high No.10 in the rankings (first posted on November 1, 2021)
- First doubles final of Klepac's career came back in 2007, on home soil in Portoroz, where she was R-Up w/Likhovtseva. Since then she has reached 18 more (record is 10-11)
- Klepac's biggest titles of career came in 2019, first at Cincinnati (w/Hradecka, d. Groenefeld/Schuurs in F) and then in final event of the season, the WTA Elite Trophy in Zhuhai (w/L.Kichenok, d. Duan/Yang)

- Making their second consecutive appearance as a team at the WTA Finals, having reached SF in 2019 (l. eventual champions Babos/Mladenovic)
- This is Stosur's fifth appearance in doubles at the WTA Finals, and the Australian is a two-time champion after winning the event in 2005 and 2006 (both with Raymond). She also qualified with Stubbs in 2009
- Zhang made her WTA Finals debut appearance alongside Stosur two years ago
- The team only played four tournaments together in 2021, lifting two titles at Cincinnati and US Open – currently on an 11-match winning streak
- Stosur has reached nine Grand Slam finals – across all four majors – with four different partners. Her four titles came at 2019 Australian Open and 2021 US Open (both w/Zhang), 2005 US Open and 2006 Roland Garros (both w/Raymond)
- Zhang has appeared in two major final and won both (2019 Australian Open, 2021 US Open). Her best previous results were 2018's semifinal showing at Flushing Meadows with Stosur and quarterfinal runs at the US Open in 2012 (w/Chuang) and 2017 (w/H.Chan)
- In mixed doubles, Stosur owns three Grand Slam titles – at 2005 Australian Open, 2008 Wimbledon (w/B.Bryan) and 2014 Wimbledon (w/Zimonjic)
- Zhang reached the semifinals in mixed doubles at 2018 US Open (w/Peers)
- Since reaching the final of their first tournament together at 2013 Osaka, Stosur and Zhang have partnered one another intermittently on tour before reuniting to reach the last four at the 2018 US Open and then win their next tournament at Hong Kong
- Stosur is a former doubles World No.1 (first achieved February 6, 2006), while Zhang currently stands at a career-high ranking of No.8 (first achieved on Oct 18, 2021)
- In singles, Stosur has a career-high ranking of No.4 (February 21, 2011). She owns nine career singles titles, including the 2011 US Open
- Zhang's best singles ranking is No.23 (November 14, 2016) and she has two career titles, at Guangzhou in 2013 and 2017
