- All four players in the Chichén Itzá group are making their WTA Finals debut
- Aryna Sabalenka** is the No.1 seed at this year's WTA Finals. The top seed has won the title at the WTA Finals 23 times, including in 2019 when Ashleigh Barty triumphed
- Sabalenka** ranks first among the players in Guadalajara for percentage of points won on first serve (71.4%), service games won (76.8%) and break points saved (62.1%)
- Sabalenka** has also hit the second highest number of aces this season (338), behind only Karolina Pliskova (364). **Maria Sakkari** is 10th in this category (234)
- Spain has two representatives in the singles field, with **Paula Badosa** joined by **Garbiñe Muguruza**. It is the first time that Spain has had multiple players competing in the event, since Arantxa Sanchez Vicario and Conchita Martinez in 2000
- Badosa** will celebrate her 24th birthday on Monday
- Iga Swiatek** is the youngest player in this year's singles competition at 20 years, 170 days old (as of the end of the tournament). She is bidding to become the youngest player to lift the title since a 17-year-old Maria Sharapova triumphed in 2004
- Swiatek** is the youngest player in this year's singles competition at 20 years, 170 days old (as of the end of the tournament). She is bidding to become the youngest player to lift the title since a 17-year-old Maria Sharapova prevailed in 2004
- Swiatek, Sakkari** and **Badosa** are among the six players to have made their Top-10 debut this season. The other three are fellow qualifiers Anett Kontaveit and Barbora Krejčíková, as well as Ons Jabeur who narrowly missed out on a place in Guadalajara
- Sakkari** posted a 7-4 record vs. Top-10 ranked opponents this year at tour-level events (including the Olympics). Before the 2021 season, the Greek was 10-13 against the Top 10
- Badosa** led the tour in clay-court match wins in 2021, posting a 17-3 record, reaching the quarterfinals at Roland-Garros, the semifinals at Madrid and Charleston and winning the title in Belgrade
- Sabalenka** enters the WTA Finals with a 44-16 record in 2021. Of these defeats, 13 have come in three-set matches (9-13 record)
- Badosa** is the only other player in the field to be involved in more than 20 matches going the distance, with her overall record standing at 16-6
- Badosa** has registered nine wins this year after losing the first set, the most wins among the participants in this year's WTA Finals. The next highest is Kontaveit on six

PLAYER NOTES

- Making debut appearance at WTA Finals - is the first Greek woman to appear at the tournament
- Finished the Porsche Race to the WTA Finals with 3341 points, securing her place with a SF run last month at Moscow
- Faces No.9 Swiatek today; hit seven aces and won 10 of 11 service games to beat the Pole in Ostrava recently, while also ended her Roland-Garros title defence this spring
- Along with Barty and Pegula, has posted a tour-leading seven Top-10 wins this season: No.4 Kenin (Abu Dhabi), No.2 Osaka (Miami), No.5 Kenin (Roland-Garros), No.9 Swiatek (Roland-Garros), No.7 Andreescu (US Open), No.4 Ka.Pliskova (US Open) and No.6 Swiatek (Ostrava)
- Across all levels, owns 7-2 career record against Polish players, with sole defeats coming to Kania (2016 Monterrey qualifying) and Linette (2019 Hobart)
- Best career results on hard are R-Up finishes at 2018 San Jose (outdoors) and 2021 Ostrava (indoors)
- Is currently ranked No.6, having broken into Top 10 after run to final in Ostrava (September 27, 2021); this time last year was No.22
- Has struck 234 aces this season, the ninth most on tour and third among the Guadalajara field (behind Ka.Pliskova on 364 and Sabalenka on 338)

PLAYER NOTES

- Making debut appearance at WTA Finals
- Is the second Polish player to participate in the Finals, following in the footsteps of 2015 champion A.Radwanska. In total, Radwanska contested the season-ending showpiece eight times, also reaching SF in 2012, 2014 and on her last appearance in 2016
- Compiled 3226 points in the Porsche Race to the WTA Finals, accumulating over a third of this total at the Grand Slams - she was the only player to make R16 or better at all four majors in 2021
- Faces No.6 Sakkari today - her first match against a Top-10 player since Rome title run in May
- Overall, owns four Top-10 wins in her career, beating No.2 Halep (2020 Roland-Garros), No.6 Kenin (2020 Roland-Garros), No.6 Svitolina (2021 Rome) and No.9 Ka.Pliskova (2021 Rome)
- Her best result on hard courts was this February's title run at Adelaide. In terms of ranking, her best win on the surface also came that week, over No.12 Bencic in the final
- Is currently ranked No.9, having first broken into Top 10 following Rome title run in spring (May 17); this time last year was No.17
- Ranks first among the players in the draw for percentage of points won on both her serve overall (62.4%) and second serve (53.1%), while is second for service games won on 75.9% (behind Sabalenka on 76.8%)
- At 20 years, 170d (at the end of the tournament) is the youngest player in the draw. Bidding to be the youngest WTA Finals champion since 17-year-old Sharapova in 2004
- Is one of three major winners in the draw (also Krejcikova and Muguruza in Teotihuacán Group)

- Upset in 2r at Indian Wells (after 1r bye, l. Golubic) before SF showing at Moscow (l. Alexandrova via ret. w/dizziness)
- Broke into Top 10 following R-Up finish at Ostrava (l. Kontaveit)
- Enjoyed SF run at US Open (l. eventual champion Raducanu); defeated three Top-20 players en route to the final four, No.11 Kvitova, No.7 Andreescu and No.4 Ka.Pliskova
- Made 3r at Olympics (l. Svitolina) and Montréal (l. Azarenka).Fell 1r at Cincinnati (l. Kerber)
- Reached 2r at Wimbledon (l. Rogers)
- At Roland Garros, became first Greek woman to reach a Grand Slam SF run at Roland-Garros (l. to eventual champion Krejckova, having held 1MP in third set)
- Started clay court campaign by reaching 2r at Stuttgart (l. Kvitova), 3r at Madrid (l. Muchova) and 2r at Rome (l. Gauff)
- Advanced to SF at Miami (l. Andreescu) - first Greek woman to reach this stage since Daniilidou in 2004
- Reached QF at Doha (l. Muguruza), then made 1r exit at Dubai (l. eventual R-Up Krejckova)
- Upset in 1r at Australian Open (l. Mladenovic)
- Began 2021 with back-to-back SFs at Abu Dhabi (d. No.4 Kenin in QF, l. eventual champion Sabalenka) and Grampians Trophy (l. Kontaveit)


- Made R16 at Indian Wells (l. Ostapenko)
- Advanced to SF at Ostrava (l. Sakkari)
- Produced R16 at US Open (l. Bencic) in what was her bestcareer result at Flushing Meadows; reached second week at all four Slams in2021 – the only player to achieve this feat this season
- Fell 2r at Olympics (l. Badosa) and Cincinnati (after 1r bye, l.Jabeur)
- Made 2r at Eastbourne (l. Kasatkina) and R16 at Wimbledon (l. Jabeur)
- Roland Garros title defense was ended in QF (l. Sakkari)
- At Rome, won third career title (d. Ka.Pliskova in F); saved 2MP in 3r win over Krejckova
- Began clay court season with 3r showing at Madrid (l. Barty)
- Reached 3r at both Dubai (l. eventual champion Muguruza) and Miami (l. Konjuh)
- Won Adelaide title without dropping a set (d. Bencic in F). Prior to Adelaide, best result on hard courts were R16 runs at the Australian Open in 2020 and 2021
- Made run to R16 at Australian Open falling to World No.2 Halep in three-sets, ending her 10-match Grand Slam win streak
- Opened 2021 season reaching 3r at the Gippsland Trophy as No.6 seed (l. Alexandrova)

CAREER MILESTONES

- Secured best year-end ranking of No.22 in 2020; broke into Top 20 on February 24 for first time, at No.20
- Scored third and fourth Top 5 wins of her career last season, over No.5 Svitolina at Ostrava and No.5 Bencic (2020 St. Petersburg). Previous wins came over No.5 Ka.Pliskova (2018 Rome) and No.5 Kvitova (2019 Rome, via ret.)
- Upset No.10 seed Keys to reach the R16 for the first time at one of the four Slams, at 2020 Australian Open (l. Kvitova)
- Qualified for WTA Elite Trophy Zhuhai in 2019 for first time in career (fell in RR stage). That season won maiden WTA title at Rabat, recovering from a set and break down to defeat Konta in final
- Highlights of 2018 were reaching her first tour-level final at San Jose (l. Buzarnescu) and scoring maiden Top 5 win over No.5 Ka.Pliskova in 2r at Rome
- Notched first Top 10 victory of career over No.6 Wozniacki en route to first WTA SF of career at 2017 Wuhan Open
- Broke into Top 50 for first time at No.49 on October 9, 2017
- At 2016 Australian Open, by reaching 2r (d. Y.Wang, l. Suárez Navarro) became the first woman from Greece to win a main draw match at a Slam since Daniilidou d. Ka.Pliskova at 2013 Australian Open
- Reached first career WTA QF at 2016 Istanbul (as qualifier, l. Kovinic)
- Fell 1r on WTA main draw debut at 2015 US Open (as qualifier, l. Q.Wang)
- WTA qualifying debut came at 2012 Palermo
- Made debut on ITF Circuit in 2010; owns seven ITF Circuit singles titles and five in doubles
- Posted career-high ranking of No.17 on October 12, 2020 for her first Top 20 season finish
- Won her maiden Tour-level title at 2020 Roland Garros without dropping a set, becoming the first player from Poland – man or woman – to win a Grand Slam singles title and first from her country to reach a major final since Agnieszka Radwanska at 2012 Wimbledon
- Ranked No.54, she became the lowest-ranked woman to win the Roland Garros title in the Open Era and the lowest-ranked finalist since 1977 (No.56 Mihai). At 19y 132d, is the youngest champion in Paris since Monica Seles (18y 187d) in 1992
- Also became the first player to win her debut Tour-level title at a Grand Slam since Jelena Ostapenko at 2017 Roland Garros
- Won WTA Most Improved Player of the Year for 2020, as voted on by members of the media. Her coach, Piotr Sierzputowski, was voted by members of the WTA Coach Program as the WTA Coach of the Year for 2020
- Also won the 2020 WTA Fan Favorite Award, as voted on by fans
- Owns six career wins over Top 10 ranked players, having defeated No.16 Q.Wang (2019 Roland Garros), No.18 Wozniacki (2019 Toronto), No.20 Vekic (2020 Australian Open), No.19 Vondrousova (2020 Roland Garros), No.2 Halep (2020 Roland Garros) and No.6 Kenin (2020 Roland Garros)
- Ended 2019 season ranked No.61 after a campaign highlighted by R-Up finish at Lugano (l. Hercog) and R16 run at Roland Garros (l. Halep)
- Also in 2019, reached 3r at Toronto (l. Osaka) and made 2r five times (incl. Australian and US Open)
- Broke into Top 100 at No.88 after R-Up finish at 2019 Lugano
- Ended 2018 season ranked No.175 (up from No.690 in 2017), after posting 42-6 record in ITF Circuit
- Highlights of 2018 campaign were four titles on the ITF Circuit, including at the \$60k clay court events in Budapest-HUN and Montreux-SUI
- Made WTA qualifying debut at 2019 Auckland
- Member of Poland's Fed Cup team, 2018-20
- On professional debut, came through qualifying to win title at \$10k ITF/Stockholm-SWE in 2016; owns seven singles titles at this level
- As junior, won girls' singles at 2018 Wimbledon (d. Küng in F) and Junior Fed Cup in 2016

- 2021 WTA Finals will be their 10th event together – they have won two titles this season to secure qualification, at Wimbledon (d. Kudermetova/Vesnina in F – saved 2MP) and Indian Wells (d. Kudermetova/Rybakina)

- Captured their maiden team title this year at Rome, having entered the tournament as an alternate team and going on to defeat two teams competing here at Guadalajara (Hsieh/Mertens and Aoyama/Shibahara) before ousting Mladenovic/Vondrousova in the final
- Other notable team results this season include R16 showings at Roland-Garros and Wimbledon, a SF run at Berlin and the QFs at Stuttgart and Eastbourne
- Aside from 2021 Rome, Fichman is the owner of three additional WTA doubles titles – 2014 Auckland (w/Sanchez), 2019 Jurmala (w/Stojanovic) and 2020 Monterrey (w/Ka.Bondarebko) from eight career finals
