- Fell 1r at Cincinnati (as qualifier, l. eventual champion Garcia) and 3r at US Open (d. No.4 Badosa in 2r, l. Azarenka)
- At Lausanne, lifted second WTA singles title (d. Danilovic in F), then made QF at Warsaw (l. Baindl)
- Best result on grass was R16 showing at Wimbledon (l. Rybakina). Also suffered 1r exits at Birmingham (l. Krunic) and Eastbourne (l. Burrage)
- On clay, reached 3r at Rome (as qualifier, l. Andreescu), 2r at Madrid (as qualifier, l. Anisimova) and Istanbul (l. eventual champion Potapova). Fell 1r at Roland Garros (l. Siniakova) Won five of her six rubbers in singles and doubles as Croatia gained promotion from its Europe/Africa group in the Billie Jean King Cup
- Advanced to QF at Indian Wells (l. Halep) and fell in qualifying at Miami
- · Made 2r at Monterrey (l. Bouzkova)
- Reached 2r at St. Petersburg (l. Mertens)
- Fell 1r at Melbourne Summer Set 1 (l. Zanevska) and Australian Open (l. Teichmann)

CAREER MILESTONES

- After back-to-back Top 20 seasons, posted fifth successive Top 100 finish in 2021 - run to SF at Rome (l. Ka.Pliskova) being the highlight
- Reached two further quarterfinals in 2021, at the Phillip Island Trophy in Melbourne (l. Kasatkina) and Emilia-Romagna (l. Q.Wang)
- Despite a disrupted 2020, reached two SFs at Dubai and Palermo, and matched best result at US Open with R16 run
- Posted best season finish of career in 2019, at No.15. Lifted maiden career WTA title at Istanbul (d. Vondrousova in F) and advanced to first Grand Slam QF of career at 2019 Roland Garros (l. eventual runner-up Vondrousova); upset No.2 seed and No.2-ranked Ka.Pliskova in 3r to register best win-by-ranking
- Also in 2019, finished R-Up at Zhengzhou before qualifying for the WTA Elite Trophy Zhuhai for the first time (fell at RR stage)
- Broke into Top 20 for first time week of September 30, 2019 (at No.17)
- In 2018, finished R-Up at Bucharest (l. Sevastova), posted QF showing at Indian Wells and made R16 at Australian Open
- In 2017, notched first Top 20 win in nearly five years over No.13 Keys at Roland Garros. Was ranked No.290 - the lowest-ranked player to reach R16 at a Grand Slam since the unranked Henin finished R-Up at 2010 Australian Open (l. S.Williams)
- In April 2017 played her first event after 10 months out with a back injury, coming through qualifying to win \$25k ITF/Santa Margherita Di Pula-ITA
- Made Top 100 debut on September 14, 2009 (after US Open; rose from No.137 to No.89) and enjoyed a Top 50 season in 2011, finishing at No.49
- Member of Croatian Fed Cup Team 2008-2010,2012, 2014
- Fell 1r on WTA main draw debut as a WC at 2007 Miami
- Made professional debut on ITF Circuit in Croatia in 2005

- Broke into Top 700 on June 6, 2022
- Won maiden ITF Circuit title at W15 event in Antalya, Turkey in May 2022
- Best result last season was SF run at W15 ITF Circuit event in Monastir, Tunisia. Finished 2021 with 14-17 win-loss record
- Owns one ITF Circuit title in singles and five in doubles
- Made professional debut on ITF CIrcuit in Japan in 2018

CAREER MILESTONES

- Broke into Top 100 on January 31, 2022, following run through qualifying to 2r at Australian Open
- Ended 2021 at No.143, her first Top 150 finish
- Reached 2r on WTA main draw debut in 2021 at Palermo (as qualifier, l. Cristian)
- Made further main draw appearances at Moscow (as qualifier, l. Tsurenko in 1r) and Courmayeur (as qualifier, l. Vekic in 1r) last season
- Also last season contested qualifying in Strasbourg
- Made WTA qualifying debut in 2019, appearing at Miami then also at Tianjin and Wuhan that year
- Made ITF debut in Australia, at a \$25k event in Playford in 2018
- Has gone on to amass seven ITF singles titles, including three in 2021

- Ended last season by lifting seventh ITF Circuit title of her career, at W80 Tyler, USA
- In Tour-level events last season, reached 3r at Phillip Island Trophy and made 2r on nine further occasions
- Best result of 2020 was R-Up finish at WTA 125K Series event at Indian Wells (l. Begu), while at Tour-level, sole main draw win came in 2r showing at Istanbul
- Appeared in her third WTA final at 2019
 Hiroshima, falling to compatriot Hibino in the
 first all-Japanese final since 1997 when
 Sawamatsu defeated Yoshida in Jakarta
- She later teamed with Hibino and won the Hiroshima doubles title - her first appearance in a WTA doubles final in four years
- Also in 2019, swept singles and doubles titles at WTA 125K Series event at Bastad
- Highlights of 2018 campaign came on the ITF Circuit, winning her sixth and seventh career titles at \$25k Kofu-JPN and \$100k Vancouver-CAN
- Best results in 2017 were SF at Nurnberg, QF at Taipei City and 3r run at Madrid
- Posted career-best finish in 2016 at No.38 (up from No.60 in 2015) while also posting new career-high ranking of No.30 (week of October 10, 2016) Notched up career-best 24 main draw match wins in 2016. Highlights were reaching second WTA singles final at Kaohsiung (l. V.Williams) and best Slam showing with R16 run at Wimbledon (d. No.17 Pliskova in 2r, l. eventual R-Up Kerber)
- Represented Japan at 2016 Rio Olympics, reaching 2r in singles (l. Stosur) and 2r in doubles (w/Hozumi, l. Kasatkina/Kuznetsova)
- Best result of 2016 clay season was Premierlevel QF at 2016 Rome (d. No.15 Safarova in 2r, l. Begu). At the time was the first Japanese player to reach QF at Premier-level tournament or above since 2014, when Date made Birmingham QF
- In March 2016, won the WTA 125k Series event at San Antonio (d. Friedsam in F)
- Won maiden WTA singles title at 2015
 Luxembourg (d. Barthel in F); scored first Top 20
 win of her career en route to title, over No.20

 Petkovic in 1r
- Lifted first WTA doubles title at 2014 Istanbul (w/Svitolina)
- In 2012, advanced to first WTA QF, at Birmingham, and SF, at Osaka

- Member of Japanese Fed Cup Team, 2011, 2013-15, 2017, 2019-20
- Scored first WTA main draw win at 2011 Kuala Lumpur (fourth tour-level main draw) and first back-to-back wins during 3r run at 2011 Wimbledon (eighth main draw)
- Played first WTA qualifying at 2009 Osaka; made main draw debut at 2010 Roland Garros
