- The third edition of the tournament features six of the Top 50, headlined by World No.29 and two-time quarterfinalist **Camila Giorgi**, who begins her challenge against home favorite **Caroline Garcia**
- No.2 seed this week is **Sorana Cirstea**, also back inside the Top 30 after a solid start to the year, highlighted by a fourth-round run at the Australian Open. Facing her in the first round here will be qualifier **Mariam Bolkvadze**
- **Viktorija Golubic** and **Alizé Cornet** are seeded No.3 and No.4 respectively, opening against **Greet Minnen** and **Cristina Bucsa**
- Last year, **Golubic** came through qualifying to finish runner-up to Clara Tauson. She is one of two former finalists in the draw, joined by the unseeded **Anna-Lena Friedsam**
- *One to Watch* – French teenager **Elsa Jacquemot** received one of three wildcards into the draw and faces qualifier Stefanie Voegelé in the first round. Two years ago, she won the girls' singles title at Roland Garros – the first French player to win a junior Slam since 2009 – and has recently begun to translate this talent into success in the senior ranks; earlier this month she reached her second ITF Circuit final and is rapidly closing in on a Top 200 debut
