**Swiatek** has won a Tour-leading 63 matches this year (including Billie Jean King Cup action)... **Swiatek** is 12-1 vs. Top 10 ranked opponents this year, including her win over Pegula in SF... **Swiatek** has compiled 23-1 record in US this season... **Swiatek** leads the Tour in Return Games Won (50.1%), Return Points won (49.8%) and Second Serve Return Points Won (61.0%)

This would be **Vekic's** 10th final appearance at the Tour-level and would be her second at the WTA 500 level, the highest level she has reached a final (R-Up at 2019 St. Petersburg)...**Vekic** has won three titles throughout her career... **Vekic** has defeated two Top 10 opponents en route to the SF (Sakkari and Sabalenka); her first tournament with two Top 10 wins since 2018 Tokyo... **Vekic** is projected to move into the Top 60 by reaching the SF this week (at No.57) and can move into the Top 50 by reaching the final and as high as No.37 with the title... There have been four qualifiers who have won titles this year so far – Maria (Bogota), Potapova (Istanbul), Pera (Budapest) and Garcia (Cincinnati); Blinkova is competing in the Cluj-Napoca final today as a qualifier

This would be her 4th singles final at the Tour-level; **Collins** was runner-up at 2022 Australian Open and is a two-time title winner, claiming titles at 2021 Palermo and 2021 San Jose... **Collins** win over Badosa was her 10th career win over a Top 10 opponents... **Collins** remains in contention for a place at WTA Finals in Fort Worth... **Collins** is projected to move to No.16 in the rankings by reaching the SF and can move to No.13 if she reaches the final (the highest she can move this week)
