TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

- The WTA returns to southern California this week for the first edition of the WTA 500-level San Diego Open
- The San Diego area has a long history with the WTA, first hosting an event won by Billie Jean King back in 1971, while more recently Carlsbad staged a WTA 125K Series tournament in 2015
- Twelve of the Top-20 players in the world are taking part this year, including three-time Grand Slam winner and current world No.1, **Iga Swiatek**
- Along with **Swiatek**, the other leading seeds, **Paula Badosa**, **Aryna Sabalenka**, and **Jessica Pegula**, have received a first-round bye
- The pick of the opening round matches sees **Elena Rybakina** take on fellow major champion **Garbiñe Muguruza**, with the winner going on to face **Swiatek**
- Leading the charge for the home nation are **Pegula** and **Coco Gauff**, while wildcards **Sloane Stephens** and **CoCo Vandeweghe** are among a total of 11 Americans in the field
- With two weeks left in the regular season, only **Swiatek** and Ons Jabeur have secured qualification for the WTA Finals in Fort Worth. Along with **Pegula** and **Gauff**, **Caroline Garcia**, **Daria Kasatkina**, **Sabalenka** and **Veronika Kudermetova** hold the remaining six qualifying positions heading into San Diego
- However, several players in the draw this week are still in the hunt for a place in Fort Worth, with wildcard **Maria Sakkari** best placed at No.9 on the Race leaderboard. **Badosa** (No.12), **Madison Keys** (No.13), **Danielle Collins** (No.16), **Liudmila Samsonova** (No.19), and **Rybakina** (No.22) are also still in contention
- *One to Watch* – **Liudmila Samsonova**. The late withdrawal of Beatriz Haddad Maia promoted the in-form Samsonova from qualifying into the main draw. Currently sitting just outside the Top 20, the 23-year-old arrives in San Diego having tasted defeat just once since the start of August, lifting titles at Washington DC, Cleveland and most recently Tokyo

WTA CHARITIES ACEING CANCER BY HOLOGIC

In honor of Breast Cancer Awareness month, together with our partners at Hologic, the WTA and WTA Charities have been spending the month of October doing our part to raise awareness and funding towards the fight against women's cancers.

Hologic is a global medical technology innovator focused primarily on women's health, including groundbreaking leadership against breast and cervical cancers. Since signing on as the title sponsor of the Hologic WTA Tour, Hologic has been committed to the WTA's mission to champion women's health by leading the "[WTA Charities ACEing Cancer by Hologic](#)" campaign.

Hologic pledged at the beginning of the year to donate for every singles ace served at a WTA 1000 and 500 level tournaments. Through October 2, **nearly \$50,000 USD** has been raised; Wimbledon champion Elena Rybakina currently tops the leaderboard at 189 aces at WTA 1000 and 500 level events, with Karolina Pliskova at 168 aces (aces from Ostrava will be added to the total at the end of the tournament).

The 2022 cancer research grant funded through the "ACEing Cancer" campaign will be dedicated to the memory of former WTA player, Jeanne Dubin, younger sister of Chris Evert, who passed away from ovarian cancer in 2020 at the age of 62.
