

In 2022, the Czechs have lost only three matches and triumphed at all three majors contested, including at US Open to complete the career golden Slam... Xu and Yang have won two titles this season at American hard-court events... Siniakova is trying to finish atop the doubles rankings for the second consecutive year; the last player to do so was Mirza (2015-16)

Pegula lost eight in a row against Top-5 opponents... Jabeur is the first African woman to qualify for the WTA Finals in singles since Coetzer in 2001

Against Jabeur on Monday, **Sabalenka** withstood 37 winners, including seven aces, coming within two points of defeat... **Sakkari's** win over Pegula on Monday was only her second against a Top-10 player this season... **Sabalenka's** win over Jabeur in opening round-robin match was Tour-leading 27th three-set encounter of 2022


[8] DESIRAE KRAWCZYK (USA #20) DEMI SCHUURS (NED #21)

Krawczyk and Schuurs will be eliminated if they lose in straight sets... Gauff has a chance to finish as year-end doubles No.1 but must win the title (and also dependent on Siniakova's results)



PLAYER NOTES

- Making 1st appearance at WTA Finals, having qualified following R-Up finish at US Open
- In 2021, narrowly missed out on a place at WTA Finals, losing out on the last qualfying spot when Kontaveit won back-to-back titles at Moscow and Cluj-Napoca
- Lost to Sabalenka in opening round-robin match, having been two points from victory in second set tie-break
- Has now been involved in 23 three-set matches this season; only Sakkari (24), Bencic (26) and Sabalenka (27) have contested more
- Faces No.3 Pegula in second match today; owns 10 wins in career over Top-10 players, most recently beating No.4 Sakkari at Rome in May
- Last Top-10 win on hard came over No.6 Svitolina during R-Up finish at 2021 Chicago [500]
- Owns 31-16 career record against players from United States, while is 12-2 this season
- First African woman to qualify for singles draw at WTA Finals since 2001, when Coetzer fell in 1r (l. Davenport)
- Bidding to become the fourth African player to win a match at the WTA Finals, joining Sally HudsonBeck (1972), Laura Rossouw (1973) and Amanda Coetzer (1993 and 2000)
- Won 46 matches this season, the second-most on Tour, behind only Swiatek; also passed the 40-win mark in 2021, posting a 48-19 record
- Entering the tournament, had struck a Tourleading 130 drop shot winners this season (not including Grand Slam matches)
- Entering this week, ranked seventh on Tour for percentage of return games won, with 40.9%; ranks third among the field in Fort Worth, behind Swiatek (49.8%) and Kasatkina (48%)
- Appeared in three career hard-court finals, finishing R-Up at 2018 Moscow [500], 2021 Chicago [500] and 2022 US Open



PLAYER NOTES

- Making first WTA Finals appearance, qualifying following SF run at San Diego
- Also playing doubles w/Gauff; first team to qualify in singles and doubles since S.Williams and V.Williams in 2009
- Last American to make debut at the WTA Finals in singles and doubles in the same year was Davenport in 1994
- In opening round-robin match, lost in two tight sets to Sakkari; first set lasted 71 minutes, longer than the entire duration of their recent final in Guadalajara
- Faces No.2 Jabeur in second match today; owns three Top-10 wins this season, over No.8 Sakkari (Australian Open), No.6 Badosa (Miami via ret.) and No.6 Sakkari (WTA Finals)
- Owns two Top-5 wins in her career, over No.2 Osaka (2021 Rome) and No.5 Svitolina (2021 Australian Open). Since beating Svitolina at Melbourne Park has lost eight in a row against members of the Top 5
- Enters WTA Finals after winning the second title of her career at WTA 1000 Guadalajara. Maiden title was also on hard courts at WTA 250 Washington DC in 2019
- Last American to win season-ending WTA Finals was S.Williams in 2014
- Currently ranked a career-high at No.3; this time last year was No.21
- Has won 42 matches so far in 2022, third-most on Tour behind Swiatek and Jabeur




SEASON 2022 HISTORY

- Advanced to QF at Monastir (l. Liu)
- During summer hard-court season, finished R-Up at US Open (l. Swiatek), reached QF at San Jose (l. Kudermetova), 3r at Cincinnati (l. Kvitova) and upset in 2r at Toronto (after 1r bye, l. Q.Zheng via ret. w/abdominal pain)
- Won title at Berlin (d. Bencic in F) and finished R-Up at Wimbledon (l. Rybakina)
- Finished R-Up at Rome (l. Swiatek) and fell 1r at Roland Garros (l. Linette)
- Lifted biggest title of her career at Madrid (d. Pegula in F), becoming the first African to win a WTA 1000-level tournament
- Finished R-Up at Charleston (l. Bencic) and reached QF at Stuttgart (l. Badosa)
- Fell 2r at Indian Wells (after 1r bye, l. Saville) and R16 at Miami (l. Collins)
- In Middle East, advanced to QF at both Dubai (l. Halep) and Doha (l. Kontaveit)
- Made QF in season opener at Sydney (ret. against Kontaveit w/lower back injury).
 Subsequently withdrew from Australian Open

- At Guadalajara, ended three-year wait for second WTA title (d. Sakkari in F); beat four Grand Slam champions en route to final
- Advanced to SF at San Diego (l. eventual champion Swiatek); also won doubles title w/Gauff to qualify for WTA Finals in Fort Worth
- Made 2r at Washington DC (l. Saville), SF at Toronto (l. eventual champion Halep) and QF at Cincinnati (l. eventual champion Garcia) and US Open (l. eventual champion Swiatek); won doubles title at Toronto (w/Gauff)
- Reached 3r at Wimbledon (l. Martic)
- Produced impressive clay-court campaign, finishing R-Up at WTA 1000 event in Madrid (l. Jabeur), advancing to QF at Roland Garros (l. eventual champion Swiatek) and 3r at Rome (l. Sabalenka)
- Won decisive doubles w/Muhammad during USA's Billie Jean King Cup 3-2 victory over Ukraine; posted 1-1 record in singles rubbers (d. Zavatska; l. Yastremska)
- Reached 3r at Charleston (l. Vandeweghe)
- Fell 2r at Indian Wells (after 1r bye, l. Bouzkova) and then advanced to SF at Miami (l. eventual champion Swiatek)
- During Middle East swing reached 2r at Dubai (l. Jabeur) and 3r in Doha (l. No.6 seed Sakkari); in doubles won the title in Doha (w/Gauff)
- Advanced to QF at Australian Open for the second year in a row (l. eventual champion Barty)
- Opened season with 1r exits at Melbourne Summer Set 2 (l. Begu) and Sydney (l. Garcia); also captured first career doubles title at Melbourne 250 2 (w/Muhammad)





CAREER MILESTONES

- In 2022, created history by becoming first African and Arab woman in Open Era to reach a Grand Slam final, finishing R-Up at first Wimbledon (l. Rybakina) and then US Open (l. Swiatek)
- Lifted biggest career title at WTA 1000 Madrid during 2022 clay-court season (d. Pegula in F)
- Broke into Top 10 on October 18, 2021, following SF run at Indian Wells (l. eventual champion Badosa)
- At 2021 Birmingham, became first Arab woman to win a WTA title (d. Kasatkina in F). Followed this with QF at Wimbledon (l. Sabalenka)
- In 2021, also finished R-Up at Charleston [250] (l. Sharma) and Chicago [500] (l. Muguruza)
- Reached maiden Grand Slam QF at 2020
 Australian Open to become the first Arab woman to reach that stage at a major (l. eventual champion Kenin); made Top 50 debut at No.45 after breakthrough performance in Melbourne
- Made further QFs in 2020 at Doha (d. No.3 Ka.Pliskova, l. Kvitova), Lexington (l. Gauff), Western & Southern Open (l. eventual champion Azarenka) and Ostrava (l. Sakkari); posted career-high ranking of No.31 on August 31, 2020
- Season highlights in 2019 were 3r run at US Open and SF appearances at Eastbourne (l. eventual R-Up Kerber) and Tianjin (l. eventual champion Peterson)
- In 2018, defeated No.3 seed Stephens, No.8 seed Kontaveit and No.5 seed Sevastova en route to her first WTA final at 2018 Moscow, where she fell in three sets to No.6 seed Kasatkina. Was first Tunisian woman to advance beyond QF at a WTA tournament (Sfar was the only other Tunisian to reach a QF at this level)
- Scored first Top-10 win over No.7 Cibulkova at 2017 Roland Garros
- Reached maiden WTA QF at 2013 Baku. Also advanced to that stage at 2017 Taipei City and 2018 Bucharest
- Three-time member of Tunisian Olympic Team, first doing so at London games in 2012
- Contested first two WTA main draws in 2012, at Doha (as WC) and Olympics
- On ITF Circuit, has 11 singles and one doubles title
- Played first event of career at 2008 ITF/El Menzah-TUN
- Became first North African woman to win a junior Slam at 2011 Roland Garros (d. Puig in F),

- At Guadalajara in October 2022, ended threeyear wait for second WTA title (d. Sakkari in F)
- Made Top-10 debut on June 6, 2022, following QF run at Roland-Garros
- In 2021, reached the QF or better on seven occasions, including at the Australian Open
- Broke into Top 20 on November 1, 2021

- Highlights of 2018 were reaching her first tourlevel final at San Jose (l. Buzarnescu) and scoring maiden Top-5 win over No.5 Ka.Pliskova in 2r at Rome
- Notched first Top-10 victory of career over No.6 Wozniacki en route to first WTA SF of career at 2017 Wuhan
- Broke into Top 50 for first time at No.49 on October 9, 2017
- At 2016 Australian Open, by reaching 2r (d. Y.Wang, l. Suárez Navarro) became the first woman from Greece to win a main draw match at a Slam since Daniilidou d. Ka.Pliskova at 2013 Australian Open
- Reached first career WTA QF at 2016 Istanbul (as qualifier, l. Kovinic)
- Fell 1r on WTA main draw debut at 2015 US Open (as qualifier, l. Q.Wang)
- WTA qualifying debut came at 2012 Palermo
- Made debut on ITF Circuit in 2010; owns seven ITF Circuit singles titles and five in doubles

- Lifted two titles during 2021 campaign, at Abu Dhabi and Madrid, while was R-Up at Stuttgart. Also reached a further three SFs, including at Wimbledon and US Open
- Rose to career-high No.2 in rankings on August 23, 2021
- In doubles, lifted second major at 2021 Australian Open (w/Mertens, d. Krejcikova/Siniakova in F)
- Won final nine matches of 2020 to end the year with back-to-back titles - at Ostrava (d. Azarenka in F) and Linz (d. Mertens in F) - and ranked at No.10
- Having also taken home the silverware at Doha (d. Kvitova in F), was one of two players (also Halep) to lift three singles titles during disrupted 2020 season

- Have qualified for the WTA Finals on three previous occasions in 2018 (I. Babos/Mladenovic in F), 2019 (Round Robin 1-2), and 2021 (Champions d. Hsieh/Mertens in F)
- Bidding to become seventh different team to defend WTA Finals, joining Navratilova/Shriver (1981-85, 1986-89, Fernandez/Zvereva (1993-94), Hingis/Kournikova (1999-00), Raymond/Stosur (2005-06), Black/Huber (2007-08), Babos/Mladenovic (2018-19)

- Had an almost perfect Grand Slam campaign this year winning three of four Grand Slams; the duo missed out on a chance to defend their Roland Garros title after Krejcikova tested positive for Covid-19 before their 1r match
- By winning US Open in September became seventh team in the Open Era to complete the career doubles Grand Slam and the second to complete the career doubles Golden Slam (also Serena and Venus Williams); only six women have achieved the latter (Pam Shriver and Gigi Fernandez both completed it with different partners)
- Also reached two SF this year, at Cleveland (I. Danilina/Krunic) and Guadalajara (I. Danilina/Haddad Maia)
- Captured their first titles as a team at Grand Slam level, winning back-to-back majors at 2018 Roland Garros and Wimbledon. Became the first pairing to complete the Roland Garros-Wimbledon double since Kim Clijsters and Ai Sugiyama won both titles in 2003
- Have been regulars at the business end of the big events ever since and last year, won Roland-Garros and won the gold medal at the Tokyo Olympics (d. Bencic/Golubic in F)
- Siniakova has held the No.1 ranking for 37 out the last 51 weeks (68 in total). Krejcikova has also occupied top spot for 19 weeks in her career (12 of these concurrently with Siniakova)
- Although Siniakova enjoyed most of her success partnering with Krejcikova, she was also R-Up at 2017 US Open with Lucie Hradecka. Overall, she holds a 20-13 record in Tour-level finals, winning the past 11. Krejcikova's career record in doubles finals sits at 14-9
- Along with six Grand Slam doubles titles, Krejcikova has one singles and three mixed doubles major titles to her name. She is one of the three active players to have won major title in singles, doubles and mixed
- In singles, Krejcikova enjoyed her best season to date in 2021, finishing R-Up at Dubai, lifting her maiden title at Strasbourg and capturing Roland Garros to break into Top 10. Siniakova is the owner of three WTA singles titles (2017 Shenzhen, 2017 Bastad and 2022 Portoroz), and has climbed as high as No.31 (October 22, 2018)
