Gauff is 1-16 in 2022 when she lost the opening set only making a successful comeback against Ruse at Wimbledon... Kasatkina is 28-0 in 2022 when winning the opening set



#### **PLAYER NOTES**

- Making 2nd appearance at the WTA Finals, where her previous outing ended in robin-round stage in Guadalajara last year
- Beat Kasatkina in opening round-robin match on Tuesday; has now won 46 WTA matches in straight sets in 2022 (excluding Billie Jean King Cup), the most since S.Williams (66) and A.Radwanska (46) in 2013
- Owns 18 wins in career over Top-10 players, most recently No.6 Daria Kasatkina at the WTA Finals this week
- Owns a Tour-best 13-1 record vs. Top 10 in 2022 (one loss was vs. No.1 Barty at Adelaide); is the first player to win 13 or more such matches in a single year since Wozniacki in 2017 (14)
- Is the third player to win 13 or more straight matches against Top-10 opponents in a single year in 2000s, after Henin (15 in 2007) and V.Williams (14 in 2001)
- Career record against Frenchwomen is 4-2, although is 0-2 this season (l. Cornet at Wimbledon and Garcia at Warsaw)
- Best result by a Polish player at WTA Finals was A.Radwanska's title run in 2015
- Is currently ranked No.1, with a 5780 point lead
- Will be the first player to finish the season with more than 10,000 ranking points (currently 10,335) since S.Williams in 2013
- Bidding to be sixth No.1 seed to win this title since round-robin reintroduced in 2003; last year, top seed Sabalenka fell in group stage
- Has won a Tour-leading 65 matches so far in 2022; this is the most in a single season since 2013, when S.Williams notched 78 wins
- Won 37 consecutive matches over the span of 135 days earlier in the year, the joint-longest win streak on the Hologic WTA Tour since 1990
- Claimed eight titles from this year Doha, Indian Wells, Miami, Stuttgart, Rome, Roland-Garros, US Open and San Diego - the most in a season since 2013 (Serena Williams won 11); also is the first player to win two Slams in a single season since 2016



#### **PLAYER NOTES**

- Making 2nd appearance at WTA Finals; advanced to SF on debut in Singapore in 2017
- The five-year gap between first and second appearances at the tournament is the fourth biggest in history; only Amy Frazier (eight), Barbara Paulus and Judith Wiesner (both six) took longer to return
- Beat Gauff in opening round-robin match; now owns 40 main-draw wins this season (only Swiatek, Jabeur and Pegula have more)
- Owns 22 wins in career over Top-10 players, including five this season: No.1 Swiatek at Warsaw, No.3 Sakkari, No.8 Pegula and No.7 Sabalenka during Cincinnati title run, and No.4 Gauff this week
- Win over No.1 Swiatek earlier this year at Warsaw was her first win over a current World No.1 in her 10th attempt (1-9 vs. No.1s); won just two sets in first nine career meetings with No.1s
- Owns 3-6 career record against players from Poland in main-draw matches; won the most recent against Swiatek at Warsaw - is the only player in the field to beat the Pole this season
- Has won three matches against Top 5 players in 2022; her joint-highest tally in a single season (also three in 2017)
- Only second to Swiatek for title wins this season; also the only player to win titles on all three surfaces
- Is currently ranked No.6; this time last year was No.74
- First French player to qualify for WTA Finals since her own run to SF in 2017; only Frenchwoman to win this title was Mauresmo in 2005 (d. Pierce in F)
- Posted 33 Tour-level wins since June, at least nine more than any other player in this timespan
- Struck 370 aces this season, the joint-most on Tour (also Rybakina); with an ace, would lock up the Tour-lead for aces in a season this year
- Entering the tournament, made Tour-leading 408 successful net approaches in 2022 (not including Slam matches)




#### SEASON 2022 HISTORY

- Finished R-Up at Ostrava (l. Krejcikova) and won title at San Diego (d. Vekic in F)
- Made 3r at Toronto (l. Haddad Maia) and Cincinnati (l. Keys) before lifting second major of season at US Open (d. Jabeur in F)
- Upset in 3r at Wimbledon (l. Cornet) result ended 37-match winning streak - and QF at Warsaw (l. eventual champion Garcia)
- On clay claimed titles at Stuttgart (d. Sabalenka in F), Rome (d. Jabeur in F) and Roland-Garros (d. Gauff in F)
- Won both rubbers during Poland's 4-0 Billie Jean King Cup victory over Romania (d. Buzarnescu and Prisacariu)
- Lifted Miami title without dropping a set (d. Osaka in F), becoming fourth woman to complete 'Sunshine Double' (also Graf, Clijsters and Azarenka)
- At Indian Wells, won fifth career title (d. Sakkari in F); is the first player to win five or more WTA titles before turning 21 since Wozniacki in 2009
- Fell 2r at Dubai (l. eventual champion Ostapenko) and then lifted title at Doha (d. Kontaveit in F) and
- Reached SF during defense of Adelaide title (l. eventual champion Barty) and also at Australian Open (l. Collins)

- Suffered exits in 2r at Tokyo (after 1r bye, l. Zhang), 1r at San Diego (l. Collins) and 3r at Guadalajara (l. Stephens)
- Fell 1r at Toronto (l. Cornet), then lifted title at Cincinnati (as qualifier, d. Kvitova in F) and reached SF at US Open (l. Jabeur)
- Returned to clay to lift title at Warsaw (d. Bogdan in F), reach SF at Lausanne (l. eventual champion Martic) and QF at Palermo (l. Bronzetti)
- Opened grass-court season with 2r showings at Nottingham (l. Riske) and Birmingham (l. Boulter) before triumphing at Bad Homburg (d. Andreescu in F) to end three-year wait for a title and reaching R16 at Wimbledon (l. Bouzkova)
- Made 2r at Roland Garros (l. Keys) and won doubles title (as WC, w/Mladenovic, d. Gauff/Pegula). Withdrew from Madrid w/right foot injury
- Suffered exits in 2r at Indian Wells (l. Raducanu) and 1r at Miami (l. Bondar)
- Advanced to SF at Lyon (l. eventual champion Zhang)
- Defeated in 1r at Dubai (as WC, l. Krejcikova) and 2r at Doha (l. Gauff)
- Upset in 1r at Australian Open (l. Baptiste, having led 6-4 5-3)
- Fell 1r at Melbourne Summer Set 2 (l. Sevastova) and made OF at Sydney (l. Krejcikova)





- In 2022, lifted second and third Grand Slam titles, at Roland-Garros (d. Gauff in F) and US Open (d. Jabeur in F)
- Triumph in Paris was the last of six straight titles during 37-match winning streak - jointlongest unbeaten run on Tour since 1990
- Won two titles in 2021, at Adelaide and Rome.
   Other highlights included QF at Roland-Garros and SF at Ostrava and qualifying for WTA Finals Guadalaiara (fell in group stage)
- Also finished doubles R-Up at 2021 Roland-Garros (w/Mattek-Sands, l. Krejcikova/Siniakova)

- Broke into Top 100 at No.88 after R-Up finish at 2019 Lugano
- Made WTA qualifying debut at 2019 Auckland
- Ended 2018 season ranked No.175 (up from No.690 in 2017), after posting 42-6 record and winning four titles on ITF Circuit
- Member of Poland's Billie Jean King Cup team, 2018-20, 2021-22
- On professional debut, came through qualifying to win title at \$10k ITF/Stockholm-SWE in 2016; owns seven singles titles at this level
- Enjoyed stellar junior career, including winning girls' singles at 2018 Wimbledon (d. Küng in F) and leading Poland to Junior Fed Cup in 2016

- Return to form in second half of 2022, winning three tournaments, including a run through qualifying to Cincinnati title (d. Kvitova in F), and career-best Slam showing with SF run at US Open (l. Jabeur)
