[1] BARBORA KREJCIKOVA (CZE #4) KATERINA SINIAKOVA (CZE #1) Head-to-Head

[5] LYUDMYLA KICHENOK (UKR #10) JELENA OSTAPENKO (LAT #16)

Krejcikova and Siniakova won both encounters between the teams this season, at Wimbledon and Guadalajara, while Kichenok and Ostapenko came out on top last year at Indian Wells... In 2022, the Czechs have lost only three matches and triumphed at all three majors contested... Kichenok and Ostapenko qualified for SF despite losing first two matches

SWIATEK: Beat Sabalenka this year during title runs at Doha, Stuttgart, Rome and US Open... Has won 15 consecutive matches against Top-10 opponents... Dropped just 13 games in the round-robin stage... Is first player under 22 to progress from the round-robin stages at WTA Finals since Kvitova in 2011... Won her past nine SF matches

<u>SABALENKA</u>: Triumphed in three sets when they met at last year's WTA Finals in Guadalajara... Bidding for third career win over a reigning World No.1... Has played 27 three-set matches in 2022... Struck a tournament-leading 34 backhand winners this week

Has won a career-best 40 main-draw matches this year... Appearing in her 15th SF since start of 2022... Contested 24 three-set matches this season

SEMIFINAL QUICK-HITS

- Swiatek spent 3h 55m on court and dropped 13 games in her three matches so far since the round robin was reintroduced in 2003, only Henin has advanced conceding fewer (11 in 2007)
- Sabalenka and Garcia secured their progress with victories in their final group matches, with the latter coming within two points of defeat against Kasatkina
- Sakkari and Swiatek are the 23rd and 24th players to finish the group stage with a perfect 3-0 record since the round robin was reintroduced in 2003
- Only eight times though has a player posted a 3-0 record and gone on to win the title, including in four of the last 10 Finals (Kvitova in 2011, S.Williams in 2012 and 2013 and Svitolina in 2018)

Meanwhile only six times has a player posted a 3-0 round robin record and failed to reach the final, most recently in 2015 (both Sharapova and Muguruza)

- Since the start of 2021, Sakkari and Swiatek have advanced to 15 semifinals, more than any other players on Tour
- All four semifinalists have been involved in 20 or more three-set matches this season
- Swiatek will finish the year with at least 11,085 ranking points, potentially amassing as many as 11,835 should she lift the title. Since the WTA Rankings were introduced, only Serena Williams recorded more points, most recently the week of June 24, 2013 (13,615 points). It will also be the second most year-end ranking points earned, behind Williams' 2013 total of 13,260
- Sakkari, Garcia and Sabalenka can finish the year as high as No.4 in the rankings
- For Sakkari to finish No.4, she will need to defeat Garcia in the semifinals and, if Sabalenka advances to the final, must win the title. While Sakkari can finish as high as No.4, she could also finish at No.5 or No.6
- With a win in the semifinals, Garcia will move to either No.4 or No.5. She will be No.6 or No.7 if she loses today
- Sabalenka needs to defeat Swiatek in order to improve on her current ranking of No.7. With a win in the semifinals, she will move into the Top 5 (at No.5).





PLAYER NOTES

- Making 2nd appearance at the WTA Finals; previous outing ended in robin-round stage in Guadalajara last year
- Beat Kasatkina, Garcia and Gauff in round robin, dropping 13 games - since reintroduction of group stage in 2003, only Henin has conceded fewer across three matches (11 in 2007)
- Posted 48 straight-set wins in 2022 (excluding Billie Jean King Cup), the most since S.Williams (66) in 2013
- Posted 15 straight Top-10 wins over past 40 years, only Navratilova in 1986 (20) and Graf in 1987 (17) have won more in a row against a Top-10 players
- Owns Tour-leading 67 wins in 2022; this is the most in a single season since 2013, when S.Williams notched 78
- Forty-seven of these wins came on hard courts; since 2000, only Clijsters (59 in 2003 and 51 in 2005), A.Radwanska (52 in 2013), Jankovic (50 in 2008) and Davenport (49 in 2001) had more in a single year
- Faces No.7 Sabalenka in SF; beat her four times this year, during title runs at Doha, Stuttgart, Rome and US Open
- Record in WTA SF matches is 13-3
- Best result by a Pole at WTA Finals was A.Radwanska's 2015 title
- Bidding to be sixth top seed to win WTA Finals since round-robin reintroduced in 2003; last year, No.1 seed Sabalenka fell in group
- Will be the first player to finish a season with over 10,000 ranking points since S.Williams in 2013
- Won 37 consecutive matches over the span of 135 days earlier in the year, the joint-longest win streak on Tour since 1990
- Claimed eight titles in 2022 Doha, Indian Wells, Miami, Stuttgart, Rome, Roland-Garros, US Open and San Diego - the most in a season since 2013 (S.Williams - 11); also is the first player to win two Slams in a season since 2016

PLAYER NOTES

- Making 2nd appearance at WTA Finals, having fallen in the group stage last year in Guadalajara
- Also played doubles at WTA Finals w/Mertens in 2019, failing to make it beyond round robin stage
- Did not secure her place at this year's WTA
 Finals until the last week of the regular season,
 thanks to the results at the WTA 1000
 tournament in Guadalajara
- Came within two points of defeat in second-set tie-break of opening round-robin victory over No.2 Jabeur; has been involved in 27 three-set matches in 2022; the most on Tour followed by Bencic (26)
- Followed this with defeat to Sakkari in second round-robin match before breaking six times to defeat Pegula and secure place in SF
- Victory over Jabeur and Pegula were third and fourth Top-10 wins of 2022, having also beaten No.6 Kontaveit and No.3 Badosa during run to Stuttgart final
- Entering this tournament, previous hard-court win over a Top-10 player was against No.9 Swiatek in their round-robin match at last year's WTA Finals
- Faces Swiatek again in today's SF; has 2-7 career record against reigning No.1s, with both wins coming over Barty at 2019 Wuhan and 2021 Madrid
- Career record in WTA SF matches stands at 17-12
- Notched up 32 Tour-level wins this season; has posted 30 or more victories in four of past five years
- Nine of her 10 career titles have come on hard courts, including one on US soil, at 2018 New Haven
- Is currently ranked No.7; will finish the season inside Top 10 for the third year in a row




SEASON 2022 HISTORY

- Finished R-Up at Ostrava (l. Krejcikova) and won title at San Diego (d. Vekic in F)
- Made 3r at Toronto (l. Haddad Maia) and Cincinnati (l. Keys) before lifting second major of season at US Open (d. Jabeur in F)
- Upset in 3r at Wimbledon (l. Cornet) result ended 37-match winning streak - and QF at Warsaw (l. eventual champion Garcia)
- On clay claimed titles at Stuttgart (d. Sabalenka in F), Rome (d. Jabeur in F) and Roland-Garros (d. Gauff in F)
- Won both rubbers during Poland's 4-0 Billie Jean King Cup victory over Romania (d. Buzarnescu and Prisacariu)
- Lifted Miami title without dropping a set (d. Osaka in F), becoming fourth woman to complete 'Sunshine Double' (also Graf, Clijsters and Azarenka)
- At Indian Wells, won fifth career title (d. Sakkari in F); is the first player to win five or more WTA titles before turning 21 since Wozniacki in 2009
- Fell 2r at Dubai (l. eventual champion Ostapenko) and then lifted title at Doha (d. Kontaveit in F) and
- Reached SF during defense of Adelaide title (l. eventual champion Barty) and also at Australian Open (l. Collins)

- Advanced to QF at San Diego (l. Vekic) and fell 2r at Guadalajara (after 1r bye, l. Samsonova)
- Reached QF at San Jose (l. Kasatkina), 3r at Toronto (l. Gauff) and SF at Cincinnati (l. eventual champion Garcia) and US Open (l. eventual champion Swiatek)
- During grass-court season posted R-Up finish at 's-Hertogenbosch (l. Alexandrova) and fell 1r at Berlin (l. Kudermetova)
- Advanced to SF at Rome (l. eventual champion Swiatek), then upset in 3r at Roland Garros (l. Giorgi)
- Finished R-Up at Stuttgart for second year in a row (l. Swiatek), then saw Madrid title defense end in 1r (l. Anisimova)
- Made 3r at Charleston (l. Anisimova)
- Fell 2r at Dubai (l. Kvitova) and QF at Doha (l. eventual champion Swiatek), then upset in 2r at both Indian Wells (after 1r bye, l. Paolini) and Miami (after 1r bye, l. Begu)
- Opened the season with opening match defeats at first the WTA 500 event in Adelaide (after 1r bye, l. Juvan) and then WTA 250 in the same city (l. Peterson). Followed by R16 showing at Australian Open (l. to Kanepi)





- In 2022, lifted second and third Grand Slam titles, at Roland-Garros (d. Gauff in F) and US Open (d. Jabeur in F)
- Triumph in Paris was the last of six straight titles during 37-match winning streak - jointlongest unbeaten run on Tour since 1990

- Won WTA Most Improved Player of the Year for 2020, as voted on by members of the media.
 Also won the 2020 WTA Fan Favorite Award
- Ended 2019 season ranked No.61 after a campaign highlighted by R-Up finish at Lugano (l. Hercog) and R16 run at Roland-Garros (l. Halep). That year also reached 3r at Toronto (l. Osaka) and made 2r five times (incl. Australian and US Open)
- Broke into Top 100 at No.88 after R-Up finish at 2019 Lugano
- Made WTA qualifying debut at 2019 Auckland
- Ended 2018 season ranked No.175 (up from No.690 in 2017), after posting 42-6 record and winning four titles on ITF Circuit
- Member of Poland's Billie Jean King Cup team, 2018-20, 2021-22
- On professional debut, came through qualifying to win title at \$10k ITF/Stockholm-SWE in 2016; owns seven singles titles at this level
- Enjoyed stellar junior career, including winning girls' singles at 2018 Wimbledon (d. Küng in F) and leading Poland to Junior Fed Cup in 2016

- Return to form in second half of 2022, winning three tournaments, including a run through qualifying to Cincinnati title (d. Kvitova in F), and career-best Slam showing with SF run at US Open (l. Jabeur)
- Only player to win titles on all three surfaces in 2022, having also triumphed on grass at Bad Homburg (d. Andreescu in F) and on clay at Warsaw (d. Bogdan in F). Summer form saw her return to Top 10 on September 12, following US Open SF
- Best win of her career came over No.1 Swiatek in QF at 2022 Warsaw
- At 2022 Roland-Garros, won first doubles title in almost six years (w/Mladenovic, d. Gauff/Pegula in F)
- Highlights in 2021 came on clay, with SF at Lausanne and OF at Parma
- Best results in 2020 were at Slams, reaching R16 at Roland-Garros (l. Svitolina) and 3r at US Open (l. Brady); defeated No.3 Ka.Pliskova in 2r at Flushing Meadows to record her first Top-10 win since late 2018
- Highlights of 2019 campaign include capturing her seventh career WTA singles title at Nottingham (d. Vekic in F) and finishing R-Up at Strasbourg (l. Yastremska)
- Member of French Billie Jean King Cup team that won the 2019 competition final vs.
 Australia, teaming up with Mladenovic to win the decisive doubles runner against Barty/Stosur. Also took part in the team that advanced to final vs. Czech Republic
- Fell out of the Top 20 on March 18, 2019 after holding her position there since August 14, 2017
- In 2018, won sixth career title at Tianjin; also made SF at Stuttgart and Madrid
- Broke into the Top 5 on August 13, 2018 and reached a career-high of No.4 on September 10, 2018
- Became first player to win Wuhan and Beijing back-to-back in 2017. As a result, qualified for WTA Finals. Was ranked No.30 on the Race to Singapore leaderboard in May 2017
- Made Top-10 debut on October 9, 2017, following completion of Wuhan-Beijing title double
- Won a career-best 48 main draw matches in 2017 (48-22 record, two titles), including reaching maiden major QF at Roland-Garros (l. Ka.Pliskova)
- Qualifying for WTA Finals in 2017, became the first Frenchwoman to compete at WTA Finals in singles since Mauresmo in 2006 (l. Henin in F)

- Historic 2021 season was highlighted by her becoming first Greek woman to break into the Top 10 (at No.10, September 27) as well as the first from her country to qualify for the WTA Finals
- In 2021, also reached third WTA final at Ostrava (l. Kontaveit), while advanced to SF at Roland-Garros, US Open - defeating three Top-20 ranked opponents at both events - and WTA Finals in Guadalajara

- Upset No.10 seed Keys to reach the R16 for the first time at one of the four Slams, at 2020 Australian Open (l. Kvitova)

- With the 2-0 in round robin play and team of Gauff/Pegula unable to advance, Siniakova is guaranteed to finish as
 WTA doubles No.1 for the second year in a row
- Were the first doubles team this year to qualify for WTA Finals, securing their place after US Open title
- Have qualified for the WTA Finals on three previous occasions in 2018 (I. Babos/Mladenovic in F), 2019 (Round Robin 1-2), and 2021 (Champions d. Hsieh/Mertens in F)
- Bidding to become seventh different team to defend WTA Finals, joining Navratilova/Shriver (1981-85, 1986-89, Fernandez/Zvereva (1993-94), Hingis/Kournikova (1999-00), Raymond/Stosur (2005-06), Black/Huber (2007-08), Babos/Mladenovic (2018-19)
- Had an almost perfect Grand Slam campaign this year winning three of four Grand Slams; the duo missed out on a chance to defend their Roland Garros title after Krejcikova tested positive for Covid-19 before their 1r match

- Krawczyk will enter her career first WTA Finals' SF, having fallen in the robin rounds at the 2021 Finals (w/ Guarachi), while Shuurs will make her third SF appearance having reached the SFs' in 2019 (w/ Groenefeld) and 2021 (w/ Melichar-Martinez)
