- The Hologic WTA Tour returns to Switzerland for the fourth edition of the Ladies Open Lausanne
- The draw is headlined by No.1 seed, **Irina-Camelia Begu** who look to improve upon last year's run where she fell in the second round. She starts her campaign against wildcard **Fiona Ferro**.
- **Tamara Zidasek** is the only former champion in the draw winning the title here in 2021. All three former runners-up will also be returning for a chance at the trophy this year: **Alizé Cornet** (2019), **Clara Burel** (2021) and **Olga Danilovic** (2022)
- The home nation of Switzerland has five representatives in the draw: **Susan Bandecchi**, **Viktorija Golubic**, **Céline Naef**, **Jil Teichmann** and **Simona Waltert**. Golubic won the tournament in 2016 when it was held in Gstaad.
- *One to watch* – **Céline Naef** made waves earlier this year in 's-Hertogenbosch when she won her WTA main draw debut defeating 7-time Grand Slam champion Venus Williams and going on to reach the quarterfinals. The 18-year-old followed up that performance by coming through three rounds of qualifying at Wimbledon to earn her first career Grand Slam main draw appearance. She owns five career ITF titles with two coming this year will have a tough task in the opening round here against the No.2 seed.
