- This is the first edition of the Mubadala Abu Dhabi Open, which will be held each year as a 500-level event
- The venue has a rich tennis history. It hosted the WTA Women's Tennis Open in 2021, an event won by Aryna Sabalenka, and the Mubadala World Tennis Championships exhibition event for the past 15 years.
- The draw is highlighted by three Top Ten players Daria Kasatkina, Belinda Bencic and Elena Rybakina, who is coming off a finalist run at the Australian Open
- Notable first round matches include the veteran matchup of **Karolina Pliskova** taking on **Garbine Muguruza**, **Jelena Ostapenko** battling **Danielle Collins**, and **Paula Badosa** facing **Liudmila Samsonova**
- There are five grand slam singles champions in the draw Rybakina, Muguruza, Ostapenko, **Barbora Krejcikova**, and **Bianca Andreescu**
- One to watch Marta Kostyuk. The young Ukrainian player has been in excellent form to start the season, with a notable win over Elena Rybakina en route to a quarterfinal finish at Adelaide #1, in addition to a third round appearance at the Australian Open. She will begin her Abu Dhabi campaign against fellow wildcard Sorana Cirstea.

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Though this is the first edition of the Mubadala Abu Dhabi Open, the tournament venue has a rich tennis history. It hosted the WTA Women's Tennis Open in 2021, an event won by 2023 Australian Open singles champion Aryna Sabalenka, and the Mubadala World Tennis Championships exhibition event for the past 15 years.
