TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

Wildcards: Bianca Andreescu (CAN), Caroline Dolehide (USA), Peyton Stearns (USA), Caroline Wozniacki (DEN) **Youngest singles player:** Marina Stakusic (17) **Oldest singles player:** Zhang Shuai (35)

- Serena Williams and Victoria Azarenka are the only two players to win the Cincinnati Open on multiple occasions. Both won twice, with Williams winning it in 2014 and 2015 and Azarenka winning it in 2013 and 2020.
- Serena Williams and Simona Halep (three each) have appeared in the most women's singles finals at the Cincinnati Open; Halep, Akiko Morigami and Angelique Kerber are the only three players to have appeared in the final on multiple occasions to have not won the title.
- Six Americans have won the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open Rosie Casals (1970), Barbara Potter (1988), Lindsay Davenport (2004), Serena Williams (2014 & 2015), Madison Keys (2019) and Coco Gauff (2023).
- No player has won more matches in the Women's Singles draw at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era than Jelena Jankovic; she has won 24 of her 32 matches in the tournament.
- Among women's players with a minimum of 10 matches at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era, Evonne Goolagong has the best win percentage of 90% (9-1).

• At 19 years and 160 days, Coco Gauff (2023) is the youngest player in the Open Era to win the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open; she is the only teenager to win the title at the tournament.

- At 33 years and 331 days Serena Williams (2015) is the oldest player in the Open Era to win the women's singles title at the Cincinnati Open.
- Caroline Wozniacki, Petra Kvitova, Sloane Stephens have the joint-most appearances at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era, all three players have made 12 appearances each.
- During the 2022 edition of the Cincinnati Open, Caroline Garcia became the first player to appear in the final of a WTA 1000 tournament as a qualifier and win it; the only other player to appear as qualifier in the final of a WTA-1000 tournament is Anna Kalinskaya at Dubai 2024.
- On two occasions wild card entrants have won title at the Cincinnati Open during the Open Era, Lindsay Davenport in 2004 and Maria Sharapova in 2011.
- Since the WTA rankings were introduced, Victoria Azarenka ranked 59 in 2020 is the lowest-ranked player to win the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open.
- In 2019, Madison Keys dropped 59 games to win the title at the Cincinnati Open, they are the most games dropped to win the women's singles title at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era.
- Since the WTA 1000 format was introduced in 2009, Ashleigh Barty in 2021 dropped just 29 games to win the title at the Cincinnati Open, they are the least games dropped to win the title. In the Open Era; Vera Zvonareva (2006) dropped just 18 games to win the title.
- Evonne Goolagong in 1973 is the only player during the Open Era to win the Women's Singles title at the Canadian Open and the Cincinnati Open during the same year.
- Since the WTA-1000 format was introduced in 2009, Iga Swiatek could become the player with outright second most titles in the format, surpassing Victoria Azarenka (10) only Serena Williams (13) currently has more.
- Since the format's inception in 2009, Iga Swiatek could become just the second player after Serena Williams (2013) to win five WTA-1000 titles in a single season, after claiming tournament victory in Doha, Indian Wells, Madrid and Rome this year.
- Iga Swiatek could register her 28th win in WTA-1000 tournaments during 2024, equalling Victoria Azarenka's 28 wins in 2012; only Serena Williams (36) in 2013 has won more such matches in a single season since the WTA-1000 format was introduced in 2009.
- No player registered more aces in the 2023 edition of the Women's Singles at Cincinnati Open than Aryna Sabalenka (18).
