This will be the 18th edition of Women's Singles at the China Open, since its inauguration as a WTA event in 2004.

Since 2004, four players have won the Women's Singles at the China Open twice - Svetlana Kuznetsova, Agnieszka Radwanska, Serena Williams and Caroline Wozniacki. Since the WTA-1000 format's introduction in 2009, only Radwanska and Wozniacki have won the event multiple times.

Svetlana Kuznetsova has appeared in the most Women's Singles finals at the China Open since the event's inauguration in 2004, appearing in the final on four occasions - 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2009.

Since 2004, Caroline Wozniacki (39) has appeared in the most Women's Singles matches at the China Open. Wozniacki is one of only three active players to appear in 20+ matches at the event along with Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova (22) and Caroline Garcia (20).



PREVIEW NOTES CHINA OPEN BEIJING, CHINA

Since the event's inauguration in 2004, Caroline Wozniacki and Agnieszka Radwanska have won the equal-most Women's Singles matches at the China Open, with the two claiming 28 wins each.

Among players with 10+ matches at the event since 2004, Serena Williams (88.2%, 15-2) holds the best winning percentage in the Women's Singles at the China Open.

Among currently active players with 10+ matches at the event since 2004, Naomi Osaka (83.3%, 10-2) holds the best winning percentage in the Women's Singles at the China Open.

Caroline Wozniacki is the only currently active player to have reached multiple Women's Singles finals at the China Open, ultimately winning the event on both occasions in 2010 and 2018.

At 18 years and 243 days, Maria Kirilenko (2005) is the youngest player to win the Women's Singles at the China Open. Kirilenko is one of the two teenagers to win the event, along with Agnes Szavay, at 18 years and 268 days in 2007.

At 32 years and 10 days, Serena Williams (2013) is the oldest player to win the title at the China Open. Williams is the only player to win the event after turning 30.

Since the event's inauguration in 2004, no qualifier has reached the Women's Singles final at the China Open, with Monica Niculescu going the furthest in 2011 - losing to Andrea Petkovic in that year's semi-final.

Since the inaugural event in 2004, no wild card has reached the Women's Singles final of the China Open, with Shuai Peng (2006) and Wang Qiang (2018) both losing in respective semi-finals to event winners Svetlana Kuznetsova and Caroline Wozniacki.

A Chinese player is yet to reach the Women's Singles final at the China Open, with Shuai Peng (2006-07), Zheng Jie (2008), Li Na (2010, 2012) and Wang Qiang (2018) all losing in respective semifinals.

Qinwen Zheng will be the second local player to appear at the China Open as a Top 10 player after Na Li (in 2011, 2012 and 2013) - this will be her second career appearance at this event after having lost in the First Round last season against Elena Rybakina.

Only two players ranked outside the WTA's Top 20 have won the Women's Singles title at the China Open - Maria Kirilenko (No.45, 2005) and Agnes Szavay (No.23, 2007).

Last year, Liudmila Samsonova (No.22) became one of four players ranked outside the WTA's top 20 to reach the final at the China Open after Maria Kirilenko, Anna Lena Groenefeld and Agnes Szavay.

Since the start of the 2020 season, only two players have claimed 50+ WTA-1000 match wins on hard court - Iga Swiatek (61) and Jessica Pegula (59).

Aryna Sabalenka won her last 12 matches: she only had two longest such streaks in WTA main draws in her career - 15 between Ostrava 2020 and Abu Dhabi 2021 and 13 between Adelaide and Dubai in 2023.

Coco Gauff will take part to their second career tournament in China after having reach the semi-finals in Beijing last year - she lost to the eventual champion Iga Swiatek.

Jessica Pegula is the player with the joint-most matches won since the Olympic Games (16, level with Aryna Sabalenka) - she reached three finals in that span (Toronto, Cincinnati and the US Open).

The China Open 2024 will be the seventh career WTA level tournament's appearance for Jasmine Paolini on Chinese soil - her best result in such events was the semi-finals made in Zhengzhou last season.

Barbora Krejcikova will take part to their second WTA-1000 event in 2024 (she lost in the First Round in Madrid to Jaqueline Cristian) and to this will be her second appearance at the China Open (she lost in the First Round to Mirra Andreeva last season).
