Maria Lourdes Carle (ARG #87) vs. [8] Veronika Kudermetova (#42) Carle leads 1-0

Carle defeated **Kudermetova** in the Madrid second round earlier this year, which was **Carle's** first Top 20 win...**Carle** is seeking her first career main-draw win at a hard-court Hologic WTA Tour event...The best result by a player from Argentina at Monterrey was Gisela Dulko's semifinal showing in 2011...**Kudermetova** is playing her first match since the Wimbledon first round, where she suffered a narrow three-hour loss to eventual champion Barbora Krejčíková...One of **Kudermetova's** two career WTA singles titles has come on hard court (2023 Tokyo)

Chloe Paquet (FRA #97) vs. Lulu Sun (NZL #64) First meeting

Paquet will face a player from New Zealand for the first time at tour level...**Paquet** made her Top 100 debut this July, just after her 30th birthday...The best result by a French player at Monterrey was Marion Bartoli's run to the title at the inaugural edition in 2009...**Sun** is the first New Zealand player in the Monterrey main draw since Marina Erakovic lost first round at the inaugural edition in 2009...**Sun** made the 2024 Wimbledon quarterfinals as a qualifier, in only her second Grand Slam main draw appearance...Directly after Wimbledon, **Sun** made her Top 100 debut at her career-high of No.53

Camila Osorio (COL #86) vs. Ajla Tomljanovic (AUS #123) First meeting

Osorio is making her fourth appearance at Monterrey, where her best result was reaching the final in 2022 (l. Fernandez in the F)... **Osorio's** best result on hard court is Runner-up on two occasions: Monterrey in 2022 and Tenerife in 2021... **Tomljanovic** is making her second appearance at Monterrey, where her previous result was reaching the quarterfinal in 2018 (l. Muguruza)... **Tomljanovic** has reached the final at three hard court tournaments: Hua Hin 2019, Seoul 2018, and Pattaya City 2015... Today will be the first meeting between the pair and first time Tomljanovic is facing a Columbian player...

Elina Avanesyan (ARM #86) vs. [WC] Elisabetta Cocciaretto (AUS #67) Cocciaretto leads 2-0

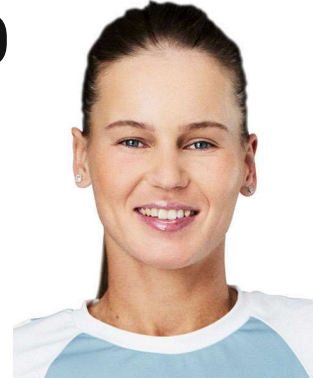
Cocciaretto won both previous encounters, most recently at Lausanne in 2023... **Cocciaretto** is making her second appearance at Monterrey, as a wildcard, where her previous result was reaching the quarterfinal in 2023 (l. Mertens)... Best result by a wildcard at Monterrey was title run by Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova in 2011... Best result by an Italian player at Monterrey was semifinal run by Sara Errani in 2015 and 2012... **Avanesyan** is making her tournament debut here at Monterrey this week... **Avanesyan** has won 20 matches so far in 2024... Owns 3-1 record against wildcards... Best career result on hard court is reaching the Round of 16 run at Cluj-Napoca and Auckland, both earlier this season...

CAREER MILESTONES

- Following two defeats at the United Cup (Cornet and Vekic), played only two other Tour level main draw matches in 2023; Bogota (l. Zhao) and Hamburg (l. Korpatsch). Closed out the year with R-Up performance at WTA 125 Buenos Aires and SF at Montevideo.
- In 2022 reached main draw at Bogota (as qualifier, l. Maria in 1r), made Grand Slam debut at Wimbledon (l. Bjorklund in Q3) and R16 at Hamburg (as qualifier, l. Potapova). Began the season ranked No. 262 and had reached No. 147 by the end.
- Made WTA Tour debut in 2021 in qualifying at Prague (l. Gasanova). Also played WTA 125s at Buenos Aires and Montevideo. Claimed first ITF title in 2017 at Buenos Aires \$15K, earning a further six over 2018-2020.
- Made ITF debut in 2014 at age of 14.
- Won second career title at 2023 Tokyo (d. Pegula in F) and finished R-Up at 2023 's-Hertogenbosch (l. Alexandrova in F); ended year at No.19 for second straight Top 20 year-end ranking
- Also in 2023, reached SF at Adelaide 2, Doha, Madrid and Rome; qualified for WTA Elite Trophy Zhuhai going 1-1 in group play
- In doubles, won titles in 2023 at Dubai with Liudmila Samsonova and Zhuhai with Beatriz Haddad Maia
- Made Top 10 debut in singles on October 24, 2022, following QF run at Guadalajara 1000 and Top 10 debut in doubles on January 31, 2022 ending the year at No.2
- Singles highlights in 2022 were R-Up finishes at Melbourne Summer Set 1 (l. Halep), Dubai (l. Ostapenko) and Istanbul (l. Potapova), and reached maiden Grand Slam QF at Roland Garros (l. Kasatkina)
- Won doubles title at 2022 WTA Finals in Fort Worth with partner Elise Mertens; also won title at Dubai and 's-Hertogenbosch with Mertens as well as Rome with Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova
- Appeared in maiden WTA final at Abu Dhabi in opening event of 2021 (l. Sabalenka) before securing first title at Charleston (d. Kovinic)
- In doubles won title at Istanbul with Elise Mertens and made final at Wimbledon (w/Vesnina) and Indian Wells (w/Rybakina) Scored first win over a Top-3 ranked opponent by upsetting No.3 Karolina Pliskova at 2020 Cincinnati. Other highlights in 2020 included SF run at Hobart and closing out season with back-to-back QFs at Ostrava and Linz
- Won 27 main-draw matches during 2019 – had previously won six across entire career - to rise over 60 places in the WTA rankings, making Top-100 debut on February 4 and Top-50 debut on September 9
- Singles highlights in 2019 included reaching SF at 's-Hertogenbosch, Hiroshima and Tianjin and 3r at Roland Garros where she defeated No.13 Caroline Wozniacki in 1r - her maiden Grand Slam main draw win and first over a Top-20 opponent)
- Also in 2019, won WTA 125K Series title at Guadalajara (d. Bouzkova in F) and entered Top 50 on Sept 9, 2019
- Posted first two Top 10 wins of career in final weeks of 2019, over No.10 Belinda Bencic at Wuhan and No.4 Elina Svitolina at Moscow
- Fell 1r on Grand Slam main draw debut at 2019 Australian Open (as qualifier, l. Kenin)

- Won career first WTA doubles title at 2019 Wuhan with Yingying Duan (d. Mertens/Sabalenka in F); also in 2019 was R-Up at Charleston (w/Khromacheva) and Lugano (w/Voskoboeva)
- Posted maiden career WTA QF runs in 2018, first at 's-Hertogenbosch (l. eventual champion Krunic) and then Gstaad (l. Bouchard)
