Sun is making tournament debut... Has beaten Chloe Paquet, Maria Lourdes Carle, Erika Andreeva and Ekaterina Alexandrova to reach her first career singles final... She owns three wins in career over Top 50 players, including this week over No.30 Alexandrova... Her previous best career result on hard court was QF run at Seoul in 2022... She is the first player from New Zealand to ever win a singles match at Monterrey... She is currently ranked No.57, close to a career high of No.53 achieved on July 15, 2020...

Noskova is also making her tournament debut... She has beaten Anna Danilina, Xiyu Wang, Elina Svitolina and Emma Navarro en route to her 3rd career singles final, having finished R-Up at Prague 2023 and Adelaide #1 2023... Best result by Czech Republic here at Monterrey was Runner-Up run by Marie Bouzkova in 2020... Is currently ranked No.35 (peak rank is No.26 achieved on June 24, 2024); this time last year was ranked No.42...

- Owns 1-0 career record against players from Czech Republic, against today's opponent Noskova at Cincinnati 2024 last week
- Owns 2 wins against seeded opponents in 2024, having defeated No.8 seed Zheng at Wimbledon and No.3 seed Alexandrova at Monterrey
- Previous best career result on hard court is QF run at Seoul 2022
- First player from New Zealand to ever win a match and go reach final at Monterrey
- Is currently ranked No.57 (career high at No.53 on July 15, 2024); this time last year was ranked No.189
- Is currently on a 4-match winning streak in main draw, having equalled her previous best winnin streak at Wimbledon 2024 en route to QF(7match winning streak if including qualifying then)
- Has won 11 matches so far in 2024

CAREER MILESTONES

- Broke into Top 200 in 2023 for first time following title run at ITF Brasilia \$80K
- Played two WTA 125 series main draw matches in 2023
- Made breakthrough at Seoul 2022, scoring her first career main draw win (d. Lizette Cabrera) en route to QF (l. eventual champion Ekaterina Alexandrova)
- Fell 1r at Granby 2022 (l. Parry)
- Played first career Grand Slam at Wimbledon 2022, falling last round of qualifying
- Made WTA main draw debut at Rabat 2022 (l. Rus in 1r)
- Played first WTA event at Bogota 2018 qualifying
- Breakthrough year in 2023, achieving runner-up twice; Adelaide 1 (as qualifier, l. Sabalenka) and Prague (l. Hibino). Also reached quarterfinals at Lyon (l. Osorio) and 3r at Indian Wells (l. Gauff) and Cincinnati (as qualifier, l. Gauff). Broke into Top 40 on October 9, 2023.
- Made Top-100 debut on August 1, 2022, following SF run at Prague (l. eventual champion Bouzkova); overtook Gauff at the youngest player in Top 100
- Also reached 2r at Tallinn (as qualifier, l. Haddad Maia) and fell 1r at both Roland Garros (as qualifier, l. Raducanu) and US Open (as qualifier, l. Bouzkova). On ITF Circuit, lifted fifth and sixth titles at this level, winning W60 tournament in Croissy-Beaubourg, France and W100 event in Versmold, Germany
- Finished 2021 campaign with 38-9 win-loss record, winning four ITF Circuit titles, including at W60 event in Prerov, Czech Republic
- Made WTA qualifying debut at 2020 Prague
- On ITF Circuit, owns six titles in singles and one in doubles
- As a junior, won 2021 girls' singles at Roland Garros.
