WTA FINALS – A BRIEF HISTORY

- This is the 53rd staging of the event (which began in 1972). This year marks the first time that the WTA Finals are hosted in Saudi Arabi and Riyadh is the 14th different city to host the year-end event.
- The singles event features eight players and begins as a round robin event, with four players in each group. Over the first six days of competition, each player meets the other three players in her group, with the top two in each pool moving on to the semifinals. Each of the group winners meets the runner-up in the other group in the semifinals. The winners of each semifinal meet in the championship match.
- The current round robin format was re-introduced in 2003 for the first time since 1982.
- Seven players have won the title at the WTA Finals in their tournament debut – Chris Evert (1972, first edition), Evonne Goolagong (1974), Serena Williams (2001), Maria Sharapova (2004), Petra Kvitova (2011), Dominika Cibulkova (2016) and Ashleigh Barty (2019).
- Other players who reached the final on their debut include Tracy Austin (1979 R-Up), Andrea Jaeger (1981 R-Up), Lindsay Davenport (1994 R-Up), Martina Hingis (1996 R-Up), Simona Halep (2014 R-Up), Sloane Stephens (2018 R-Up) and Anett Kontaveit (2021 R-Up)
- The longest Finals win streak was compiled by Navratilova, who won 21 straight matches in winning five titles between 1983 and 1986 and reaching the quarterfinals in 1987. The next longest win streak in tournament history is S.Williams, who won 16 in a row (2009, 2012, 2013 and 2014)
- Between 1984 and 1998, a best-of-five sets final was used to decide the Finals final; three finals went the distance: 1990 - Seles vs. Gabriela Sabatini (the first woman's match in 89 years to extend to five sets since the 1901 Philadelphia Finals); 1995 – Steffi Graf vs. Anke Huber; 1996 - Graf vs. Hingis. Six finals went to four sets (1986 - March, 1987, 1989, 1991, 1993 and 1998)
- On 10 occasions has a Finals winner has not dropped a set en route to the title; Evert achieved the feat three times (1972-73, 1975) and Navratilova (1984-85) and S.Williams (2001, 2012) did it twice; Sabatini did not drop a set in 1988, while Clijsters did the same in 2002 and Swiatek is the most recent, in 2023
- There have been 26 different winners in 52 stagings; of those 26 winners, 19 have reached No.1 in the WTA Rankings with the only exceptions were Sylvia Hanika (1982), Gabriela Sabatini (1988, 1994), Jana Novotna (1997), Petra Kvitova (2011), Agnieszka Radwanska (2015), Dominika Cibulkova (2016), Elina Svitolina (2018) and Caroline Garcia (2022)
- The top seed has won the title 23 times, most recently Ashleigh Barty in 2019

DOUBLES QUALIFIERS

Lyudmila Kichenok & Jelena Ostapenko – The Ukrainian-Latvian pairing will be making their second appearance together at the prestigious season-ending tournament, having reached the semifinals in 2022. The team reached four finals this season on the Hologic WTA Tour winning titles at the US Open (which was both players first Grand Slam title), Brisbane and Eastbourne. In addition they finished as runners-up at the Australian Open.

Hsieh Su-Wei & Elise Mertens – Mertens, from Belgium, and Hsieh Su-Wei of Chinese Taipei are making their second appearance at the WTA Finals as a team having finished as runners-up in 2021, while both players are former champions with Mertens triumphing in 2022 and Hsieh Su-Wei lifting the title in 2013. They secured their qualification courtesy of three titles this season, winning the Australian Open, Indian Wells and Birmingham.

Sara Errani & Jasmine Paolini - While Paolini will be making her WTA Finals debut, Errani is no stranger to the prestigious season-ending event having competed in doubles from 2012-14 and in singles in 2012 and 2013. The Italian duo picked up early season silverware at the Linz then tasted success on home soil by winning Rome. They finished as runners-up at Roland-Garros before rounding out a fairytale summer by winning the gold medal in doubles at the Paris Olympics and confirmed their qualification by winning the China Open in Beijing.

Gaby Dabrowski & Erin Routliffe - This season will mark Dabrowski's sixth overall appearance at the WTA Finals, while her partner Routliffe made history at the event last season as the tournament's first ever qualifier from New Zealand. The team, who went undefeated in the group stages in 2023, won the title at Nottingham and reached a further four finals at Toronto, Miami, Eastbourne and Wimbledon.

Katerina Siniakova & Taylor Townsend – Townsend will be making her WTA Finals debut, while Siniakova is set to make her sixth consecutive appearance at the event and she has reached the final three times, winning the title in 2021 and finishing as runner-up in 2018 and 2022. The Czech-USA duo only teamed up in May but enjoyed instant success, reaching the quarterfinals at Rome then securing the title at Wimbledon, along with a semifinal run at the US Open.

Desirae Krawczyk & Caroline Dolehide - This season marks Krawczyk's fourth consecutive appearance at the WTA Finals, while partner Dolehide will step out on court at the WTA's crown jewel event for the first time in her career. The all-American pairing have reached two WTA 1000 finals this season, winning Toronto and finishing as runners-up in Doha in addition to reaching two Grand Slam semifinals, at Roland-Garros and Wimbledon.

Chan Hao-Ching and Veronika Kudermetova - Chan Hao-Ching and Kudermetova will be making their team debut at the WTA Finals this season, with both having appeared before with other partners – Kudermetova lifted the title on her only other outing in 2022, while 2024 marks Chan Hao-Ching's fourth appearance overall. They paired up in April of this year and enjoyed almost instant success, winning their second event together at Stuttgart before reaching a further three finals, at Beijing and at back-to-back tournaments at the Berlin and Bad Homburg.

Nicole Melichar-Martinez & Ellen Perez – The pair are set to appear together at the WTA Finals for the second time, having finished as runners-up in 2023. They have claimed two titles this year at San Diego and Bad Homburg, as well as reaching the final at the Dubai and Linz.

ABOUT THE ROUND ROBIN FORMAT

- In 2003 the current round robin format feeding into a four-player single-elimination draw returned to the WTA Finals for the first time since 1982. The Top 2 finishers in each group will advance to the semifinals where the top player in each group, will play against the other group's runner-up
- There have been 26 instances where a player has posted a perfect 3-0 record in round robin play, most recently 2023 champion Iga Swiatek and 2023 runner-up Jessica Pegula
- On nine occasions has a player posted a 3-0 record and gone on to win the title, most recently in 2023 (Swiatek).
- Meanwhile nine times has a player posted a 3-0 round robin record and failed to reach the final, most recently 2022

ROUND ROBIN TIE-BREAKING METHODS

Since 2003, a semifinalist has been decided by the round-robin tie-break method nine times (2003, 2004, 2009, 2011, 2013, twice in 2015, 2016 and 2021). The final standings of each group shall be determined by the following:

- 1) Greatest number of wins
- 2) Greatest number of matches played; or
- 3) Head-to-head results if only two (2) players are tied, or if three (3) players are tied then:
 - a. If three (3) players each have the same number of wins, a player having played less than all three (3) matches is automatically eliminated and the player advancing to the single elimination competition is the winner of the match-up of the two remaining tied players; or
 - b. Highest percentage of sets won; or
 - c. Highest percentage of games won

If the above tie-breaking methods produce one (1) superior player (1st place) or one inferior player (3rd place), and the two (2) remaining players are tied, the tie between those two (2) players shall be broken by head-to-head record.
