2024 US OPEN

First held in 1887, the US Open women's singles championship is being staged for the 138th time. The 2024 event marks the 57th staging of the Open Era, which began in 1968 and saw the introduction of prize money. Overall, this is the 144th US Open, the men's event having first being held in 1881.

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STORYLINES

- This will be the 57th edition of the Women's Singles at the US Open, the 138th edition of the event all-time.
- Serena Williams and Chris Evert have won the Women's Singles title at the US Open on the equal-most occasions in the Open Era, winning the event six times each.
- Serena Williams has appeared in the most Women's Singles finals at the US Open in the Open Era, holding a win-loss record of 6-4 from her 10 appearances. Williams is the only player in the Open Era to reach 10+ Women's Singles finals at multiple Grand Slam events – Wimbledon (11), US Open (10).
- Among players with 10+ matches at the event in the Open Era, Margaret Court (90.6%, 29-3) holds the best winning percentage in the Women's Singles at the US Open.
- Among active players with 10+ matches at the event in the Open Era, Bianca Andreescu (85.7%, 12-2) holds the best winning percentage in the Women's Singles at the US Open.
- Victoria Azarenka (0-3), Caroline Wozniacki (0-2) and Naomi Osaka (2-0) are the only active players to reach multiple Women's Singles finals at the US Open.
- In the Open Era, Serena Williams (2002, 08, 14) and Chris Evert (1976-78) have won the Women's Singles title the most times at the US Open without dropping a set. The last player to achieve the feat was Emma Raducanu (2021).
- Winning the US Open in 2021, Emma Raducanu is the only qualifier in the Open Era to appear in and win a Women's or Men's Singles final at a Grand Slam event.
- In the Open Era, Martina Navratilova, Monica Seles and Angelique Kerber are the only three left-handed players to win the Women's Singles title at the US Open.
- Chris Evert (31) has recorded the most consecutive Women's Singles match wins at the US Open in the Open Era. Only two players in that span have recorded more consecutive Women's Singles match wins at a single Grand Slam – Martina Navratilova (47, Wimbledon) and Monica Seles (33, Australian Open).
- Venus Williams (24) has appeared in the most Women's Singles main draws at the US Open in the Open Era. Williams is one of four players to appear in 20+ main draws at the event along with her sister Serena, Martina Navratilova (21 each) and Amy Frazier (20).
- Last year, Coco Gauff became one of four American players since 2000 to win the Women's Singles title at the US Open along with Venus Williams (2000-01), Serena Williams (2002, 08, 12-14) and Sloane Stephens (2017).
- After winning this year's Australian Open, Aryna Sabalenka could become the first female player to win both hard-court Grand Slam titles in the same year since Angelique Kerber (2016).
- Since the Australian Open's switch to hard court in 1988, Aryna Sabalenka could become the fifth female player to reach both hard-court Grand Slam finals in consecutive seasons after Steffi Graf (1988-90, 93-94), Monica Seles (1991-92), Martina Hingis (1997-99) and Victoria Azarenka (2012-13).



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- Currently holding a record of 79-17, Iga Swiatek (82.3%) holds the best winning percentage at Grand Slam events of any currently active player.
- Among players to have started their career in the Open Era, only six players could achieve 80 Women's Singles wins in fewer Grand Slam matches than Iga Swiatek (97) – Monica Seles (86), Chris Evert (89), Martina Hingis (92), Serena Williams, Steffi Graf (93 each) and Venus Williams (94).
- Jessica Pegula could become only the fourth player in the Open Era to reach the Women's Singles finals at the Canadian, Cincinnati and US Opens in a season after Rosemary Casals (1970), Evonne Goolagong Cawley (1973) and Serena Williams (2013).
- Jasmine Paolini has both hit the most winners (409) and converted the most break points (80) in Women's Singles matches at Grand Slams this year.
- Elena Rybakina (85) has served the most aces in Women's Singles matches at Grand Slams in 2024.

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PIF WTA WORLD NO.1 RANKING

For the 11th major in a row, **Iga Swiatek** enters as WTA World No.1. Swiatek attained the ranking on April 4, 2022, following the retirement of Ashleigh Barty and held the top spot for 75 consecutive weeks. Swiatek's first stay atop the rankings came to an end after the 2023 US Open when Aryna Sabalenka took over the No.1 spot after reaching the final. Swiatek regained the World No.1 ranking on the final day of the 2023 season by winning the title match at the WTA Finals. This fortnight at the US Open will mark Swiatek's 118th (week of August 26) and 119th (week of September 2) weeks at No.1 and she will extend her stay at No.1 after the US Open, regardless of any results:

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ACTIVE GRAND SLAM CHAMPIONS

The 2023 season welcomed three new Grand Slam champions: **Aryna Sabalenka** won her maiden Grand Slam singles title at the Australian Open, **Marketa Vondrousova** triumphed at Wimbledon and **Coco Gauff** lifted the US Open crown.

In 2024 three different players have won a Grand Slam title. **Aryna Sabalenka** and **Iga Swiatek** have defended their titles at the Australian Open and Roland-Garros respectively, and **Barbora Krejckova** won her second Slam title at Wimbledon, having previously won the title at 2021 Roland-Garros.

There are 18 active Grand Slam champions, eight of whom have lifted the trophy previously at US Open: **Coco Gauff** (2023) **Iga Swiatek** (2022), **Emma Raducanu** (2021), **Naomi Osaka** (2018, 2020), **Bianca Andreescu** (2019), **Sloane Stephens** (2017), **Svetlana Kuznetsova** (2004) and **Venus Williams** (2000-01).

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STRONG OFF THE BLOCKS – FIRST-ROUND SUCCESS

Of those players with six or more Grand Slam appearances in this year's US Open draw, here are the players with the best strike rate in the opening round at a Grand Slam:

- **Iga Swiatek (21-1 in 1r, 95.45%):** Swiatek has been defeated in 1r only once in 22 Grand Slam main draw appearances, at 2019 Wimbledon (I. Golubic). Swiatek is 5-0 in first round matches at the US Open
- **Emma Raducanu (8-1 in 1r, 88.89%):** Raducanu's only loss came at 2022 US Open (I. Cornet) as defending champion
- **Madison Keys (39-5 in 1r, 88.64%):** Has won nine-straight Slam opening round matches with last loss coming at 2021 US Open (I. Stephens). Keys is 10-2 here at US Open in opening matches
- **Caroline Wozniacki (47-7 in 1r, 87.04%):** The former World No.1 is 13-1 in first round matches at the US Open, with her only loss in New York coming to Begu in 2012. She has won her last six R128 matches across all Slams with her last loss coming at 2019 Roland Garros
- **Elise Mertens (26-4 in 1r, 86.87%):** Mertens fell at the first hurdle three times in her first four Grand Slam main-draw appearances, however, following this she won 18 straight matches at this stage before this run ended at 2022 US Open (I. Begu)
- **Elina Svitolina (36-6 in 1r, 85.81%):** Svitolina has won 32 of her last 33 opening round matches at Slams – dating back to 2015 Australian Open – with only loss during that time coming at 2018 Wimbledon (I. Maria)
- **Coco Gauff (17-3 in 1r, 85%):** Only first-round defeats came at 2020 US Open (I. Sevastova), 2022 Australian Open (I. Q.Wang) and 2023 Wimbledon (I. Kenin)
- **Elena Rybakina (17-3 in 1r, 85%):** Two of Rybakina's first round exits at Slams came on her first two outings at the majors, at 2019 Roland-Garros (I. Siniakova) and 2019 US Open (I. Muchova). She also suffered an opening round loss at 2022 US Open (I. Burel)

Lepchenko (38) is not only the oldest woman in the draw, but is also the third oldest woman to earn a spot in the main draw at the US Open via qualifying in the Open Era.

At 33y 198d, Flavia Pennetta (2015) is the oldest player in the Open Era to win the Women's Singles title at the US Open. Since the event switched to hard court in 1978, Pennetta is one of three aged 30+ to win the event along with Martina Navratilova (1987) and Serena Williams (2012-14).

In 2014 Serena became the first woman to win the US Open three times in a row since Chris Evert won four consecutive titles in 1975-78. Riyadh, Saudi Arabia will host the next three editions of the WTA Finals from 2024-2026. The 2024 season-ending Finals will take place between November 2-9, featuring the Top 8 singles players and doubles teams in the Race to the WTA Finals.

The qualification process for the WTA Finals has been modified. Players can earn race points at WTA 250 level, WTA 500 level, WTA 1000 level and Grand Slams. In addition to race point totals being adjusted slightly – all WTA 1000 reward 1000 points, WTA 500s reward 500 points, etc - players are now allowed to count a maximum of 18 tournaments in singles and 12 in doubles.

Top 7 players/teams on Leaderboard qualify with the 8th spot being rewarded to either the highest ranked Grand Slam champion No.8-20 on Leaderboard OR the next highest point total.
