Youngest singles player: Clervie Ngounoue (19) | Oldest singles player: Venus Williams (45)

- Serena Williams and Victoria Azarenka are the only two players to win the Cincinnati Open on multiple occasions. Both won twice, with Williams winning it in 2014 and 2015 and Azarenka winning it in 2013 and 2020.
- Serena Williams and Simona Halep (three each) have appeared in the most women's singles finals at the Cincinnati Open; Halep, Akiko Morigami and Angelique Kerber are the only three players to have appeared in the final on multiple occasions to have not won the title.
- Jelena Jankovic holds the tournament record for most match wins having won 24 of her 32 matches.
- At 19 years and 160 days, Coco Gauff (2023) is the youngest player to win the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open; she is the only teenager to win the title at the tournament.
- At 33 years and 331 days Serena Williams (2015) is the oldest player to win the women's singles title at the Cincinnati Open.

- During the 2022 edition of the Cincinnati Open, Caroline Garcia became the first player to appear in the final of a WTA 1000 tournament as a qualifier and win it; the only other player to appear as qualifier in the final of a WTA 1000 tournament is Anna Kalinskaya at Dubai 2024.
- Venus Williams returns to Cincinnati making her 11th tournament appearance and first since 2023. A semifinalist in 2012 and quarterfinalist in 2019, Williams is a wildcard in this year's draw.
- On two occasions wild card entrants have won title at the Cincinnati Open during the Open Era, Lindsay Davenport in 2004 and Maria Sharapova in 2011.
- Victoria Azarenka (then No.59) in 2020 is the lowest-ranked player to win the singles title at the Cincinnati Open.
- Since the WTA 1000 format was introduced in 2009, Ashleigh Barty in 2021 dropped just 29 games to win the title at the Cincinnati Open, they are the least games dropped to win the title.
- Aryna Sabalenka and Jelena Jankovic are the players who have the most wins against Top 10 in Women's Singles at the Cincinnati Open (5 each).
- Since 2004, Aryna Sabalenka in 2024 became the third player to win the title at the Cincinnati Open without dropping a set after Ashleigh Barty in 2021 and Vera Zvonareva in 2006.
- Aryna Sabalenka (47) is the player with the most wins during the 2025 season at WTA-level.

SUMMARY OF PERFORMANCE BYE & SPECIAL EXEMPT SPOT

With both finalists in Montreal being unseeded – Naomi Osaka and Victoria Mboko – performance byes will be awarded in addition to the byes for the Top 32 seeds at the tournament, yielding 34 byes in the opening round at Cincinnati.

As Mboko was a direct entry into the Cincinnati qualifying draw, she received "Special Exempt Spot" into the main draw at Cincinnati. A "Special Exempt Spot" is a singles Main Draw spot reserved for a singles player who is unable to compete in the Qualifying of a WTA Tournament in which she has been accepted as a direct acceptance by the Qualifying Sign-In Deadline because she is still competing in the singles main draw of a Tournament in the week before the Special Exempt Tournament.

ABOUT THE UPCOMING PIF WTA RANKINGS

With a Thursday final in Montreal, the PIF WTA Rankings will updated at the conclusion of the tournament's championship matches. At that time, any ranking points earned at 2024 Washington DC and 2024 Toronto will drop off the Rankings with 2025 Montreal points being added. These will be the rankings for August 11, for historical and record purposes.

Further, the August 11 Rankings will update on Sunday evening at the conclusion of the ITF events allowing for points to be applied to the respective players' Ranking points. The PIF WTA Rankings will next be updated on Monday, August 18 at the conclusion of the Cincinnati final at which point the 2024 Cincinnati points will drop off with 2025 Cincinnati points being added, accordingly. These rankings will serve as the basis for US Open seeding.






