TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

Youngest singles player: Ruien Zhang (17)
Oldest singles player: Tatjana Maria (38)

This will be the 19th edition of the Women's Singles at the China Open, since its inauguration as a WTA event in 2004 – this will also be its 14th as a WTA-1000 event.

Since 2004, four players have won the Women's Singles at the China Open twice - Svetlana Kuznetsova, Agnieszka Radwanska, Serena Williams and Caroline Wozniacki. Since the WTA-1000 format's introduction in 2009, only Radwanska and Wozniacki have won the event multiple times.

Svetlana Kuznetsova has appeared in the most Women's Singles finals at the China Open since the event's inauguration in 2004, appearing in the final on four occasions - 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2009.

Since the WTA-1000 format's inception in 2009, no player has reached back-to-back Women's Singles finals at the China Open.

Since 2004, Caroline Wozniacki (39) has appeared in the most Women's Singles matches at the China Open, while Shuai Zhang (28) has appeared in the most at the event among active players.

Since the event's inauguration, Caroline Wozniacki and Agnieszka Radwanska have won the equal-most Women's Singles matches at the China Open, with the two claiming 28 wins each.

After winning the event last year, Coco Gauff (90.9%, 10-1) now holds the best winning percentage in the Women's Singles at the China Open, since 2004 – minimum 10 matches.

Maria Kirilenko (2005) is one of two teenagers to win the event, along with Agnes Szavay (2007).

Claiming tournament victory in 2013, Serena Williams (32 years) is the oldest player to win the Women's Singles title at the China Open - since the event's inauguration, Williams remains the only player aged 30+ to win the event.

Winning the event in 2005, Maria Kirilenko (#45) is the lowest-ranked player to win the Women's Singles title at the China Open, since its inception in 2004.

Since the event's inauguration, Svetlana Kuznetsova has conceded the fewest games en route to the Women's Singles title at the China Open, conceding only 21 games in 2006.

Claiming tournament victory last year, Coco Gauff (51) has conceded the most games en route to the Women's Singles title at the China Open, since its inauguration in 2004.

Since 2004, a Chinese player is yet to reach the Women's Singles final at the China Open, with five players losing in respective semi-finals at their home event – Peng Shuai, Zheng Jie, Li Na, Wang Qiang and Qinwen Zheng.

Achieving the feat last year, Karolina Muchova (#49) is the lowest-ranked player to reach the Women's Singles final at the China Open, and the lowest-ranked to claim multiple WTA top 10 wins at a single edition of the event.

Since 2004, Petra Kvitova and Maria Sharapova have claimed the equal-most WTA top 10 wins at the China Open with five each, while Shuai Zhang (four) has the most among currently active players.

Since the event's inauguration in 2004, two players have defeated the WTA #1 in the Women's Singles final at the China Open – Svetlana Kuznetsova (2006) and Naomi Osaka (2019).

Since the event's inauguration, no qualifier has reached the Women's Singles final at the China Open - Monica Niculescu has gone the furthest of any qualifier at the event, reaching the semi-final in 2011.

A wildcard is yet to reach the Women's Singles final at the China Open since its inauguration in 2004 - Peng Shuai (2006) and Wang Qiang (2018) both reached the semi-final as wildcards.

Since 2004, the defending Women's Singles champion has lost their opening match at the next edition of the event on four occasions – Serena Williams (2005), Jelena Jankovic (2009), Svetlana Kuznetsova (2010) and Victoria Azarenka (2013).

Naomi Osaka (2019) remains the only player representing an Asian country to reach a Singles final (Women's or Men's) at the China Open, since the inauguration of the Men's event in 1993.

Iga Swiatek's opening match will be her 150th at WTA-1000 events – since 2009, only Serena Williams (131) has claimed more wins than Swiatek (121) from that opening span of matches.

Elena Rybakina (166) has served the most aces and holds the highest rate of points won on first serve (73.8%) of any player at WTA-1000 events in 2025 – minimum 10 matches.

Only three currently active players have now appeared in more main draws at WTA-1000 events than Madison Keys (86) – Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova (118), Victoria Azarenka (101) and Sorana Cirstea (87).
