MAIN DRAW QUICK HITS

Wildcards: Emma Navarro, Victoria Rodriguez, Maria Sakkari, Ajla Tomljanovic

Youngest singles player: Linda Noskova (20) Oldest singles player: Tatjana Maria (38)

- Linda Noskova of the Czech Republic returns as the defending champion. She won her first WTA singles title here last year as the No.6 seed and she is seeded No.6 again this year. Noskova is also the youngest player in the main draw (excluding qualifiers).
- Emma Navarro is No.1 seed this week as a wild card. Currently ranked World No.11, Navarro played just her second career WTA main draw here in 2020. This year, she will be making her fifth appearance after reaching semifinals last year before falling to Noskova.
- Taking the last seeded spot is No.8 Anastasia Pavlyuchenkova, who is the Monterrey tournament title leader, and
 making her first appearance at the event since 2019. Pavlyuchenkova has won here four times between 2010 and
 2017, and holds a 24-3 win-loss record.
- This week's No.7 seed Leylah Fernandez has also won multiple Monterrey titles, winning back-to-back in 2021 and 2022. Fernandez has a 12-1 match record here, with her only loss against eventual champion Elina Svitolina in the 2020 quarterfinals.
- Donna Vekic is another former Monterrey champion in this year's field winning the title in 2023 by defeating No.5 ranked Caroline Garcia in the final
- Along with Navarro, the Top 4 seeds (who all receive first-round byes) are No.2 Ekaterina Alexandrova, No.3 Diana Shnaider, and No.4 Beatriz Haddad Maia. Alexandrova and Haddad Maia are both former Monterrey semifinalists (in 2024 and 2022 respectively), while Shnaider has lost her only previous Monterrey match (in 2023).
- Tatjana Maria is the oldest player in the main draw at age 38. Maria is going for her second WTA 500 title of the year she won at Queen's, London as a qualifier, becoming the oldest player to win a WTA 500 event. Consequently, she hit a career-high ranking of No.36 last month.
- The doubles main draw is led by No.1 seeds Gabriela Dabrowski and Erin Routliffe. Dabrowski and Routliffe have won 10 Tour-level doubles titles as a team (two this year), including the 2023 US Open.


