TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

Youngest singles player: Mirra Andreeva (18) | **Oldest singles player:** Laura Siegemund (37)

This will be the eighth edition of the tournament. The tournament dates back to 2014 and the winner of inaugural edition of the tournament was Petra Kvitová.

Aryna Sabalenka (2018, 2019, 2024) has won the title three times with a 17-0 record at the tournament.

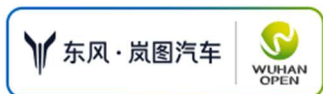
Venus Williams is the oldest player to win the title at the Wuhan Open, in 2015 when she was 35 years and 108 days old - currently the oldest champion in a single WTA-1000 event since the format's introduction.

At 20 years old, Aryna Sabalenka (2018) is youngest player to win the title in Wuhan since the inception of the tournament in 2014.

The furthest a wild card has progressed in the tournament is reaching the semi-finals, Qiang Wang progressed to the semi-final as a wildcard in 2018.

Venus Williams ranked World No. 24 in 2015 is the lowest-ranked player to win the title at Wuhan Open since the inception of the tournament in 2014.

Caroline Garcia (in 2017) is the only player able to secure both China and Wuhan Open titles in a single year.
