- Star-studded field features four Top 10 players and in total nine Top 20 players, led by No.1 seed, Jessica Pegula, who just finished R-Up at Miami (I. Sabalenka in champion match)
- No.2 seed is 2019 champion, newly crowned 2025 Australian Open champion Madison Keys
- Qinwen Zheng and Emma Navarro rounds out Top 4 seeds
- No.5 seed Daria Kasatkina, is playing her first event representing Australia



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- Other former champions in this year's field include defending champion Danielle Collins, Belinda Bencic (2022), Veronica Kudermetova (2021)
- Currently there are four Americans in the Top 10 of the PIF Race to WTA Finals leaderboard – Madison Keys, Emma Navarro, Jessica Pegula and Amanda Anisimova. (Coco Gauff also sits at No.12)
- Wild cards are granted to home country's Lauren Davis and Maria Mateas, Canada's Marina Stakusic and Great Britain's Heather Watson
