## CAREER MILESTONES

- Highlights of the 2024 season were reaching R16 at s'Hertogenbosch and quarterfinal at WTA 125 Guadalajara; also played opening round main draw at Australian Open, Roland Garros and Wimbledon
  - In 2023 reached SF at Seoul (l. Yuan) and QF at s'Hertogenbosch (l. Alexandrova). Also won WTA 125 Tampico and broke into Top 100 for first time.
  - Made Grand Slam main draw debut at Australian Open and Wimbledon in 2022.
  - Reached 1r main draw at Cleveland (l. Linette) and San Jose (l. Garcia) in 2021.
  - In 2017 earned second ITF title at Albuquerque \$80K; also played first WTA Tour matches at Hua Hin, reaching 1r as a qualifier (l. Duan).
  - Made professional debut on ITF circuit in 2012 at Evansville \$10K. Following year claimed first title at the same event.
  - In 2024 earned second career title at Bogota (d. Bouzkova) as well as semifinals at WTA 500 Guadalajara and WTA 125 Lleida
  - Made SF run at 2023 Lyon (l. Garcia). Advanced to R16 at Rome (l. Haddad Maia) for the first time at a WTA 1000 after notching first Top 5 win (over Garcia).
- Also in 2023 reached the QF at Palermo (l. Sherif) and Nanchang (l. Bouzkova). Earned first Top 5 victory at 2023 Rome against Carolina Garcia.
- In spring of 2022, made QF at Guadalajara 250 (l. Kalinskaya), R-Up run at Monterrey (l. Fernandez), and SF at Bogota (l. Pigossi) in title defense campaign
  - Biggest win of 2022 season came against No.19 Ekaterina Alexandrova in 1r at Guadalajara late in the season
  - Won maiden WTA title on home soil, at 2021 Bogota (d. Zidansek in F); at No.180 was the lowest-ranked WTA title winner since No.299 Gasparyan triumphed at 2018 Tashkent
  - In 2021, also finished R-Up in final event at Tenerife (l. Li), reached SF at Charleston [250] and Belgrade, and battled through qualifying to reach 3r at Wimbledon
  - Made Top-100 debut on May 24, 2021, following run through qualifying to SF at Belgrade
  - Finished 2020 ranked at No.186 - the same position she ended 2019 campaign, too. Best results were SF at \$25k ITF/Saint-Malo- FRA., while contested qualifying at Australian Open and Roland Garros
  - In 2019 won second and third career ITF Circuit titles, both at \$25k Guayaquil-ECU
  - Won first ITF Circuit singles title at \$15k Cucuta-COL
  - Colombian Billie Jean King Cup Team 2016-17, 2019
  - Fell 1r on WTA main draw debut at 2017 Bogota (as WC, l. Blinkova)
  - Made professional debut in qualifying at 2016 Bogota (l. Perrin in 3s)

## CAREER MILESTONES

- Kicked off the year with a career high ranking of No.43 on Jan 8, 2024. Over the season achieved a best result of QF at Bogota (l. eventual champion Osorio) and made two WTA 125 finals at Barranquilla and Guadalajara.
  - Won second consecutive title at Bogota 2023 (d. Stearns in F) for third career singles title overall. Reached SF at Warsaw (l. Siegemund) and Cleveland (l. eventual champion Sorribes Tormo).
  - Highlight of 2022 season was SF run at Wimbledon (l. Jabeur)
  - Also won title in 2022 at Bogota (as qualifier, d. Pigossi in F), made SF at Seoul and QF at Granby
  - Missed the first half of 2021 season, returned in July and contested a mixture of qualifying, WTA 125K Series and ITF Circuit events
  - Ended 2019 ranked No.90. Highlights were first R16 showing at a WTA Premier Mandatory event at Miami (d. No.6 Stephens in 3r, l. Vondrousova)
  - Won fourth doubles title of career at 2019 Seoul (w/Arruabarrena); now 4-4 in doubles finals
  - Ended 2018 season at No.79 after a campaign in which she clinched her maiden WTA singles title at 2018 Mallorca (d. No.20 Sevastova in F). Also won doubles title at Acapulco (w/Watson)
  - Finished 2017 by cracking into the Top 50 for the first time in her career; jumped 69 spots from No.115 in 2016 to a career-high No.46 in 2017
  - Played 33 tournaments in 2017, more than any other player, a feat all the more notable for the fact she was joined at all but a few tournaments by her young daughter, Charlotte
  - Reached first career WTA SF of career at 2017 Quebec City (l. eventual champion Van Uytvanck); also made three QF appearances across the season, at Rabat, Bucharest and Linz
  - Maiden WTA QF came at 2009 Barcelona
  - Owns four Top 10 wins in career, over No.10 Li at 2010 Kuala Lumpur, No.7 Bouchard at 2015 Miami, No.5 Svitolina at 2018 Wimbledon and No.6 Stephens at 2019 Miami
  - Winner of 15 singles and 15 doubles titles on ITF Circuit
  - Played first events of career on ITF Circuit in 2001 and made WTA main draw debut in 2006
  - In 2024 produced a breakthrough performance at WTA 125 Charleston by reaching the final and entered the Top 200 for the first time and a career high of No.169 in November
- Played Grand Slam qualifying for the first time in 2021 at US Open and by 2024 was up to her ninth ITF singles title
- In 2019 collected her fourth ITF title at W15 Arcadia
  - Played first Tour level match in qualifying at Seoul 2018 as a wild card

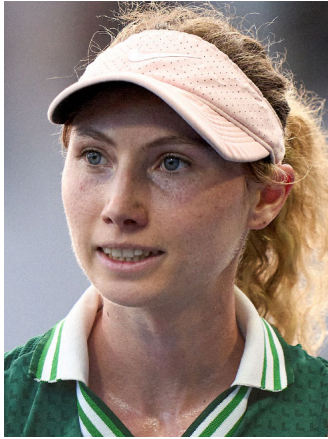
