DOUBLES FINAL NOTES - SUNDAY, JUNE 8

ANNA DANILINA (KAZ #17) / ALEKSANDRA KRUNIC (SRB #79) vs.
[2] SARA ERRANI (ITA #6) / JASMINE PAOLINI (ITA #6)

Danilina / Krunic:

- This is the first time the two have ever paired up at a Grand Slam and third time teaming up at all reaching the final at 2022 Cleveland (I. Melichar-Martinez/Perez) and falling first round at 2022 Budapest.
- Danilina is into her second Grand Slam final finishing Runner-Up at 2022 Australian Open with Beatriz Haddad Maia (I. Krecjikova/Siniakova); other best Grand Slam result was reaching QF at 2024 US Open (w/Khromacheva), however before this year had never gone beyond the second round at Roland Garros
- Krunic is making her Grand Slam final debut, best previous results were QF at 2021 Australian Open (w/Trevisan) and QF at 2021 Wimbledon (w/Stojanovic); her previous best result at Roland Garros was reaching the Round of 16 in 2016 (w/Lucic-Baroni) and this is her first year advancing past the first round since 2018
- The two earned their spot in the final by beating three seeded teams including upsetting the No.1 seeded team of Katerina Siniakova and Taylor Townsend in the quarterfinals.
- Danilina owns nine career WTA doubles titles including her first WTA 1000 title at Wuhan last year (w/Khromcheva) and reached a career high of No.10 in 2023
- Krunic has earned seven WTA doubles titles including one this year at Rouen also on clay (w/Santamaria)

Errani / Paolini:

 This is the sixth time the two have paired up at a Grand Slam and are into their second final reaching this stage here at Roland Garros last year (I. Gauff/Siniakova)

- On Tour, the two have won seven titles together including the 2024 Olympic Gold Medal here in Paris and four WTA 1000 titles at 2024 Beijing, 2024-25 Rome and 2025 Doha. They also qualified for the 2024 WTA Finals Riyadh together going 1-2 in group play.
- Errani is appearing in her 10th career Grand Slam doubles final looking for her sixth career title and second at Roland Garros winning previously at 2012 Roland Garros (w/Vinci), 2012 US Open (w/Vinci), 2013-14 Australian Open (w/Vinci) and 2014 Wimbledon (w/Vinci). Also finished Runner-Up at 2012 Australian Open (w/Vinci), 2013-14 Roland Garros (w/Vinci), and 2024 Roland Garros (w/Paolini)
- Errani also owns two Mixed Doubles Grand Slam title including here at Roland Garros this year with Andrea Vavassori (the two also won Mixed Doubles title at 2024 US Open). With a win in the Women's Doubles final, would become the first player to win both the Women's and Mixed Doubles titles in a single Grand Slam event since Su Wei Hsieh at the Australian Open 2024 (paired with Elise Mertens and Jan Zielinski) and the first at Roland Garros since Bethanie Mattek-Sands in 2015 (paired with Lucie Safarova and Mike Bryan).
- Reaching the final here last year was Paolini's first and only previous Grand Slam doubles final; also reached two singles Grand Slam finals last year at Roland Garros (I. Swiatek) and Wimbledon (I. Krejcikova)
- The two earned their spot in the final this year without dropping a set and beating three seeded teams en route including a 6-0, 6-1 win in the semifinals over Mirra Andreeva and Diana Shnaider, a rematch of the Olympic Gold Medal match on these courts last summer
- Errani owns 33 career WTA doubles titles and has reached as high as World No.1 (last in 2015).
- Paolini owns eight WTA doubles titles and is currently at her career high doubles ranking of No.6.
