- Owns one WTA doubles title; 2023 Charleston with Krawczyk (d. Olmos/Shibahara in F)
- Reached the women's doubles SF at 2022 Wimbledon with Krawczyk (l. Mertens/Zhang)
- Her best singles result at the US Open was 4r in 2022 (l. Sabalenka), also reached the singles final at 2022 Australian Open (l. Barty)

#### HARRISON QUICK HITS:

- Playing in his fourth US Open mixed doubles event after losing in 1R in 2015 (w/Duval) and 2017 (w/Anisimova), before advancing to 2018 SF (w/McHale)
- Entered the draw after withdrawal of team Siniakova/Sinner
- Teamed up with Melichar-Martinez this season, advancing to 2R of Roland Garros and losing in Wimbledon 1R
- Ranked No. 108 on PIF ATP Doubles Rankings on 19 August last year, he re-entered into Top 100 in October, Top 50 in March and Top 20 in May and earned 32 of 45 career tour-level men's doubles wins in 2025
- Teamed up with Evan King to win 2 ATP Tour titles at 2025 Dallas and 2025 Acapulco, both as Q. Also reached ATP Tour finals at 2021 Delray Beach w/R. Harrison, 2025 Auckland w/R. Ram and 2025 Delray Beach w/E. King
- His older brother, Ryan, won 2017 Roland Garros men's doubles title w/Michael Venus.
- In singles, earned 1st of 6 career tour-level wins at 2013 Atlanta (d. Falla), advanced to 2021 Delray Beach SF as No. 789-ranked qualifier (d. No. 22 Garin in 2R) and reached 2022 Wimbledon 2R (d. Clarke in 1R).
