TOURNAMENT TALKING POINTS

- Serena Williams (2014 and 2015) and Victoria Azarenka (2013 and 2020) are the only two players in the Open Era to win the title at the Cincinnati Open on multiple occasions.
- Serena Williams and Simona Halep (three each) have appeared in the most finals at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era - Halep (0-3), Akiko Morigami (0-2) and Angelique Kerber (0-2) are the only three players to have appeared in the final on multiple occasions to have not won the title.
- Six Americans have won the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era - Rosie Casals (1970), Barbara Potter (1988), Lindsay Davenport (2004), Serena Williams (2014 and 2015), Madison Keys (2019) and Coco Gauff (2023) - more than any other country in that time span.
- Jelena Jankovic is the player with the most main draw wins at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era (24), while Serena Williams (23) has the most among current player and Aryna Sabalenka (21) has the most among those appearing at the event this season.
- Among players with a minimum of 10 matches at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era, Evonne Goolagong holds the best win percentage at the event (90%, 9-1).



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- Caroline Wozniacki is the player with the most appearances at the Cincinnati Open during the Open Era (13) - Sloane Stephens will equal Wozniacki this year thanks to the wild card received.
- Caroline Garcia has claimed the Cincinnati Open's title in 2022 as a qualifier: she is still the only qualifier / lucky loser to have secured a WTA-1000 since the format's introduction in 2009.
- On two occasions wild card entrants have won title at the Cincinnati Open in the Open Era, Lindsay Davenport in 2004 and Maria Sharapova in 2011.
- Since the WTA Rankings were introduced in 1975, Victoria Azarenka (World No. 59) in 2020 is the lowest-ranked player to win the title at the Cincinnati Open.
- Evonne Goolagong in 1973 is the only player in the Open Era to win the titles at the Canadian Open and in Cincinnati during the same year.
- Aryna Sabalenka and Jelena Jankovic are the players who have the most wins against Top 10 opponents at the Cincinnati Open since the WTA Rankings were published in 1975 (five each).
- Iga Swiatek in 2025 became the first Polish player in the Open Era to win the Women's or Men's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open.
- At 19 years and 160 days, Coco Gauff (2023) is the youngest player to win the Women's Singles title at the Cincinnati Open; she is the only teenager to win the title at the tournament.
- At 33 years and 331 days Serena Williams (2015) is the oldest player to win the women's singles title at the Cincinnati Open.



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PIF WTA RANKINGS FOR WEEK OF AUG 10, 2026

PIF WORLD NO.1 RANKING – SINGLES (Incl. Week of August 10 & August 17, 2026)

Including the weeks of August 10 and August 17, Aryna Sabalenka has held the PIF WTA World No.1 Ranking for 96 consecutive weeks (since October 21, 2024), bringing her career total weeks at No.1 to 104 weeks.

With a Thursday final in Toronto, the PIF WTA Rankings will be updated at the conclusion of the tournament's championship matches. These will be the rankings for August 10, for historical and record purposes with points from 2025 Montreal dropping off and 2026 Toronto being added.

The PIF WTA Rankings will next be updated on Monday, August 24 at the conclusion of the Cincinnati tournament at which point the 2025 Cincinnati points will drop off with 2026 Cincinnati points being added, accordingly. These rankings will serve as the basis for US Open seeding.

The WTA World No.1 Ranking will be on the line in Cincinnati. The exact scenarios remain dependent on the results in Toronto.

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PIF WORLD NO.1 RANKING – DOUBLES (Incl. Week of August 10 & August 17, 2026)

Katerina Siniakova has held the No.1 Doubles Ranking since May 4, 2026. Including the weeks of the Cincinnati tournament, her career total weeks at No.1 will increase to 195 and 196. Siniakova owns the third most weeks as the Doubles No.1 behind only Martina Navratilova (237 weeks) and Liezel Huber (199 weeks).

Elise Mertens is the only other player to hold the Doubles No.1 ranking this year. Mertens held the No.1 spot for 13 consecutive weeks from Feb 2 – May 3.
