- This year's ASB Classic main draw is led by No.1 seed Elina Svitolina of Ukraine. The former World No.3 is making her second appearance at the tournament after reaching the final here on her maiden appearance in 2024. Svitolina had an excellent 2025 season, winning her 18th career title at Rouen, making semifinals at Madrid, and quarterfinal runs at Rome, Roland Garros and Australian Open. She posted a season-ending Top 20 finish for the first time since 2021.
- No.2 seed Emma Navarro returns to Auckland having reached the semifinals on her tournament debut in 2024. Both the American's career Tour titles have come at WTA 250 events – Merida 2025 and Hobart 2024. As well as her title at Merida in 2025, other season highlights comprised of seven quarterfinal runs including a third straight Australian Open quarterfinal.
- Iva Jovic is the No.3 seed at this year's ASB Classic on her tournament debut, and is the youngest player to receive direct entry into the main draw. The young American had a breakthrough 2025 season where she won her first Tour-level title aged 17 at WTA 500 Guadalajara, rising from World No.73 to No.36 following her triumph in Mexico. This week in Auckland is the first time Jovic has been within the Top 5 seeds at a WTA event.
- Rounding off the Top 4 seeds at Auckland is Alexandra Eala of the Philippines. Eala is making her ASB Classic debut in 2026 after emerging onto the WTA Tour in 2025 following a phenomenal run at Miami as a qualifier ranked No.140, where she defeated World No.5 Keys and No.2 Swiatek to reach the semifinals. Eala went on to reach her first career Tour-level final on the grass at Eastbourne and then won her maiden career WTA 125 title at Guadalajara 125, ending the 2025 season at a career-high ranking of No.50. During the off-season, the twenty-year-old took home the singles Gold medal for the Philippines at the 2025 Southeast Asian Games in Thailand.
- Also in the field is seven-time Grand Slam singles champion Venus Williams, who is making her seventh appearance at Auckland after winning the title in 2015 (d. Wozniacki in F) and reaching the final in 2013 (l. Ivanovic). In the first round, Williams will face 5th seed Magda Linette, who she owns a 2-0 career record against.
