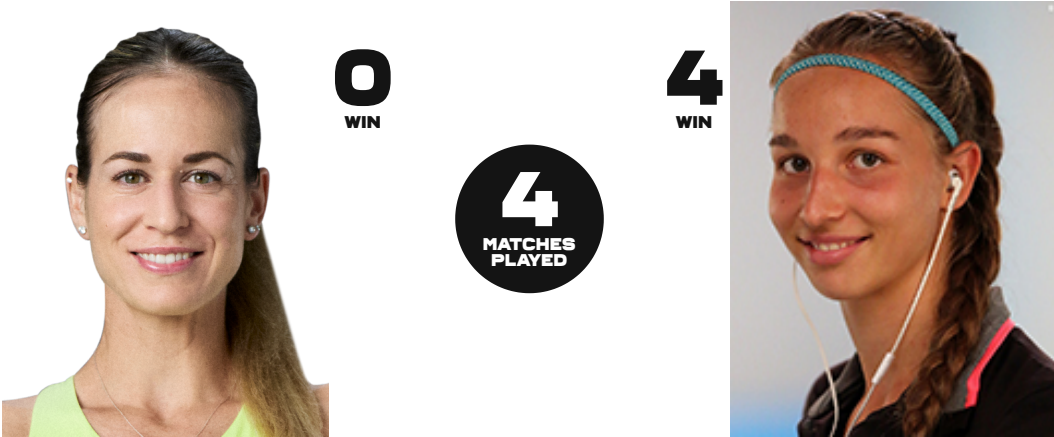

PLAYER NOTES

- Making 2nd appearance at this event, where she finished R-Up last year (l. Boisson in F) - that was her first career WTA final
- Defeated Moyuka Uchijima, Noma Noha Akugue, Alina Charaeva and Elina Avanesyan this week, reaching her 2nd career WTA final
- Faces No.81 Tamara Korpatsch in today's final; Bondar is 16-9 at Tour-level this year vs. players ranked outside the Top 50
- Owns 7-8 career Tour-level record against players from Germany (4-0 in 2026, including a 2r win over Noha Akugue this week)
- Career-best Tour-level results on clay are her 2 finals at this event, this year and last year
- 1 of 2 players from Hungary in this week's main draw (No.3 seed Udvardy lost in 2r)
- Best results by Hungary at this event are Bondar's two finals in these last two editions
- A victory today would be her 20th Tour-level match-win of the season (and it would be her 14th of those match-wins on clay)
- Before this week, her best Tour-level results of the year were 3 QFs at Hobart, Rouen and Rabat
- Bondar has won two career WTA 125 titles - one of those titles came in Hamburg in 2024 (d. Arantxa Rus in F)
- Is currently ranked No.97; this time last year was ranked No.59. Reached career-high ranking of No.50 in July 2022

PLAYER NOTES

- Making 5th appearance at this event, where she has surpassed her previous best tournament results of reaching 2r in 2021, 2023 and 2025
- Defeated Victoria Jimenez Kasintseva (via ret.), Julia Stusek, No.2 seed Anhelina Kalinina and Mayar Sherif (via ret.) this week, making her 3rd career WTA final
- This is her 2nd WTA final of the year; she finished R-Up at 2026 Ostrava in February on hard court (l. Boulter in F)
- Seeking her 2nd career WTA title; her first WTA title was at 2023 Cluj-Napoca on hard court (d. Elena-Gabriela Ruse in F)
- Faces No.97 Anna Bondar in today's final; Korpatsch is 8-4 at Tour-level this year vs. players ranked outside the Top 50
- Owns 2-0 career Tour-level record against players from Hungary, which are her 2 Tour-level wins against today's opponent Bondar at 2021 Gdynia and 2024 Ningbo
- This is her career-best Tour-level result on clay
- Her previous career-best Tour-level clay results were SFs at 2019 Lausanne (l. eventual R-Up Cornet) and 2021 Gdynia (l. eventual R-Up Kucova)
- 1 of 8 players from Germany to start this week's main draw, and the only one to reach QF and beyond
- At this tournament, Germany had R-Up finishes by Noma Noha Akugue in 2023 (l. Arantxa Rus in F) and Andrea Petkovic in 2021 (l. Elena-Gabriela Ruse in F)
- Is currently ranked No.81; this time last year was ranked No.156. Reached career-high ranking of No.71 in October 2023

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CAREER MILESTONES

- In 2025 reached first Tour final of her career at Hamburg (l. Boisson), defeating No.1 seed and world No.16 Alexandrova en route to the final. Competed in the main draw at all four Slams winning 1r matches at Roland Garros and US Open (d. No.15 Svitolina in 1r)
- In 2024, won second career WTA 125 title at Hamburg (first came at 2021 Buenos Aires). In doubles reached the final at Bogota w/Khromacheva and earned WTA 125 titles at Hamburg and San Luis Potosi (both with Zimmerman)
- In 2023 won first Grand Slam main draw match defeating Bogdan in 1r at Australian Open; also reached semifinal at Lausanne (l. Cocciaretto) and made 3r at Rome (as qualifier, l. Zheng)
- Highlights of 2022 were SF at Rabat (withdrew w/right shoulder injury before match versus Liu) and QF at Lyon (l. Cirstea), Istanbul (l. Kudermetova) and Palermo (l. Sorribes Tormo)
- Won first career title on Tour in doubles at Palermo (w/Zimmermann)
- Made Top 100 debut on November 15, 2021, following title run at W60 ITF Circuit event in Santiago, Chile
- Ended 2021 in fine form, winning 27 matches after US Open, lifting titles at WTA 125K Series event at Buenos Aires and two ITF Circuit tournaments
- In 2020, reached two QFs on ITF Circuit and made 2r at WTA 125K Series event at Prague
- Suffered 1r defeat on WTA main draw debut at 2019 Budapest (l. Cirstea). Also that year, fell 1r at Bucharest (as qualifier, l. Tig) and in qualifying on three occasions
- Contested Grand Slam qualifying for the first time at 2019 Wimbledon
- Won the most recent of her 10 ITF Circuit singles titles in January 2019, at \$25k Daytona Beach, FL-USA
- Fell at first hurdle on debut in WTA qualifying at 2018 Budapest
- Made professional debut on ITF Circuit in 2014, winning a title in only her second event, at \$10k Antalya-TUR
- In 2025, best Tour-level result was Jiujiang QF (l. eventual finalist Taggar); also won two ITF Circuit titles (W75 Trnava and W50 Funchal) and made WTA 125 SF at San Sebastian
- At Tour-level in 2024, scored main draw match-wins at Australian Open, Roland Garros, Ningbo and Jiujiang; also made quarterfinals at WTA 125s Hamburg and Bastad
- In 2023, won first WTA Tour singles title at Cluj-Napoca (d. Ruse in F); also reached SF at Prague (l. Noskova) and WTA 125 Valencia (l. Bassols Ribera) and hit a career-high ranking of No.71 on October 23
- Top results in 2022 include first WTA 125 title at Budapest (made Top 100 debut afterwards on September 26), WTA 125 R-Up at Marbella, and ITF/W25 title at Le Havre-FRA; best Tour-level results were 2r at Lyon and Stuttgart
- Singles highlight in 2021 was SF run at Gdynia (l. Kucova) and also reached 2r at Bad Homburg and Hamburg; in doubles that year, advanced to first WTA final at Budapest (w/Bolsova, l. Buzarnescu/Stollar)
- Made Grand Slam main draw debut at 2020 US Open and played another Grand Slam main draw at 2020 Roland Garros (in autumn), falling 1r on both occasions
- Reached maiden WTA SF at 2019 Lausanne (l. Cornet)
- Reached QF at 2018 Lugano (l. Voegele)
- In 2017, made 2r in Tour-level debut at Budapest (as qualifier, l. Dodin); later in year, reached first career WTA Tour QF at Gstaad (l. Sorribes Tormo)
- WTA qualifying debut came at 2016 Gstaad
- Lifted first ITF Circuit title in 2015 at Brno-CZE
- Made debut on ITF Circuit in Braunschweig, Germany in 2011
