DOUBLES FINAL – SUNDAY, JUNE 7

[1] KATERINA SINIAKOVA (CZE) / TAYLOR TOWNSEND (USA)

[2] ANNA DANILINA (KAZ) / ALEKSANDRA KRUNIC (SRB)

Danilina/Krunic lead 2-1

Danilina/Krunic defeated Siniakova/Townsend in each of the first two meetings between these teams, in the 2025 Roland Garros QF (7-5, 4-6, 6-2) and the 2026 Australian Open QF (6-2, 3-6, 6-0). (Danilina/Krunic went on to the finals at both of those Grand Slam events and finished as runners-up each time.)

Siniakova/Townsend won the next (and most recent) meeting in the head-to-head between these two teams, defeating Danilina/Krunic in the 2026 Indian Wells final 7-6(4), 6-4.

PIF WTA Ranking Watch: WTA Doubles World No.1 Siniakova and No.2 Townsend will remain in those positions following Roland Garros, win or lose.

No.5 Krunic and No.6 Danilina will remain in those positions if they finish as runners-up, but if they win the title, Krunic is projected to rise to No.4 and Danilina is projected to rise to No.5.

Siniakova/Townsend Quick Hits

Team W-L in doubles: 70-14

- Siniakova/Townsend have now reached their 4th Grand Slam final as a team (2-1 in Grand Slam finals)
- As a duo, they won Grand Slam titles at 2024 Wimbledon (d. Dabrowski/Routliffe in final) and 2025 Australian Open (d. Hsieh/Ostapenko in final)
- They made their other team Grand Slam final at 2025 US Open (l. Dabrowski/Routliffe in final)
- As a team, they are 24-2 in 2026, including three consecutive WTA 1000 titles at Indian Wells, Miami (completing the Sunshine Double) and Madrid
- They won 17 consecutive matches as a team during that timeframe, before their team winning streak was snapped by Bucsa/Melichar-Martinez in the 2026 Rome SF
- Seeking their seventh title as a team; along with their 2 Grand Slam titles and the 3 WTA 1000 titles they have won this year, they also prevailed at WTA 1000 Dubai in 2025
- Siniakova and Townsend teamed up for the first time at 2024 Rome (l. Gauff/Routliffe in quarterfinals)
- In just their third event together, they won the 2024 Wimbledon title
- Qualified together for the WTA Finals in 2024 (l. Dabrowski/Routliffe in final) and 2025 (l. eventual champions V. Kudermetova/Mertens in semifinals)

Siniakova:

- Currently ranked World No.1 in doubles and will remain at that position following Roland Garros (win or lose)
- Reached World No.1 in doubles for the first time on October 22, 2018; she has spent a total of 185 weeks holding the World No.1 doubles ranking (including the weeks of May 25 and June 1, 2026 during Roland Garros)
- She holds the third-most weeks at WTA Doubles World No.1, trailing only Martina Navratilova with 237 weeks and Liezel Huber with 199
- She is already a 10-time Grand Slam champion in women's doubles (7 titles with Krejčíková, 2 with Townsend and 1 with Gauff)
- Her 3 prior Roland Garros women's doubles titles came in 2018, 2021 (both w/Krejčíková) and 2024 (w/Gauff)
- Won the 2021 Olympic gold medal in women's doubles (w/Krejčíková) – she is one of seven women to have completed the Career Golden Slam in doubles (winning all four Grand Slam events plus Olympic gold)
- In mixed doubles, she won the 2024 Olympic gold medal (w/Machac) and the 2025 Wimbledon title (w/Verbeek)
- Has won 36 WTA Tour doubles titles in her career overall, including 4 this year
- She has also won 5 WTA singles titles in her career and holds a career-high singles ranking of No.27 (June 2024)

Townsend:

- Currently ranked World No.2 in doubles and will remain at that position following Roland Garros (win or lose)
- Reached World No.1 in doubles for the first time on July 28, 2025; she held the top ranking for a total of eight weeks last summer
- She is already a 2-time Grand Slam champion in women's doubles, both titles alongside Siniakova (2024 Wimbledon and 2025 Australian Open)
- This is her 2nd Roland Garros women's doubles final; she finished as 2023 runner-up alongside Leylah Fernandez (l. Hsieh/Wang Xinyu in F)
- Overall, this is her 6th career Grand Slam final in women's doubles
- She is also a 2-time mixed doubles Grand Slam runner-up at 2024 US Open (w/Young) and 2025 Roland Garros (w/King)
- Has won 15 WTA Tour doubles titles in her career overall, including 4 this year
- Townsend reached her first WTA Tour singles final at Austin in March of this year (l. Stearns in final); she also won the doubles title that week (w/Hunter)

Danilina/Krunic Quick Hits

Team W-L in doubles: 47-16

- Danilina and Krunic are into their third Grand Slam final as a team, and they are into the Roland Garros final for the second straight year
- They finished as runners-up at 2025 Roland Garros (l. Errani/Paolini in F) and 2026 Australian Open (l. Mertens/Zhang in F) – they defeated today’s opponents Siniakova/Townsend in QF at both of those events
- Seeking their third Tour-level title as a team, having prevailed at 2025 Cleveland (d. Chan/Jiang in F) and WTA 1000 Doha in February of this year (d. Hsieh/Ostapenko in F)
- They have a 23-6 team record this year – this is their first event as a team since Miami in March
- Entered Roland Garros as the No.2 team in the Race to the WTA Finals, trailing today’s opponents Siniakova/Townsend by 80 Race points
- Danilina and Krunic paired up for the first time on Tour in 2022, playing two events together that season and finishing as runners-up at Cleveland (l. Melichar-Martinez/Perez in final)
- They did not team up again until 2025 Roland Garros – at that event, in just their third tournament playing together, they made the final as an unseeded pair, defeating three seeded teams en route
- Were doubles alternates at the 2025 WTA Finals Riyadh (they did not play any matches there)

Danilina:

- Currently ranked World No.6 in doubles; she hit her career-high doubles ranking of No.4 on March 16 of this year
- This is her 4th career women’s doubles Grand Slam final – along with her 2 runner-up finishes with Krunic, she was also the 2022 Australian Open R-Up with Beatriz Haddad Maia (l. Krejčíková/Siniakova)
- She has won one Grand Slam title in mixed doubles, pairing with Harri Heliövaara to win that event at the 2023 US Open (d. Pegula/Krajicek in final)
- Has won 12 WTA Tour doubles titles in her career, including one this year (WTA 1000 Doha with Krunic)

Krunic:

- Currently ranked World No.5 in doubles; she hit her career-high doubles ranking of No.4 on May 18 of this year
- Is contesting her 3rd career Grand Slam final, all alongside Danilina
- Has won 9 WTA Tour doubles titles in her career, including one this year (WTA 1000 Doha with Danilina)
- Krunic has been as high as No.39 in the singles rankings, winning one WTA Tour singles title (2018 's-Hertogenbosch) and reaching R16 as a qualifier at 2014 US Open (l. the previous year’s finalist Azarenka)

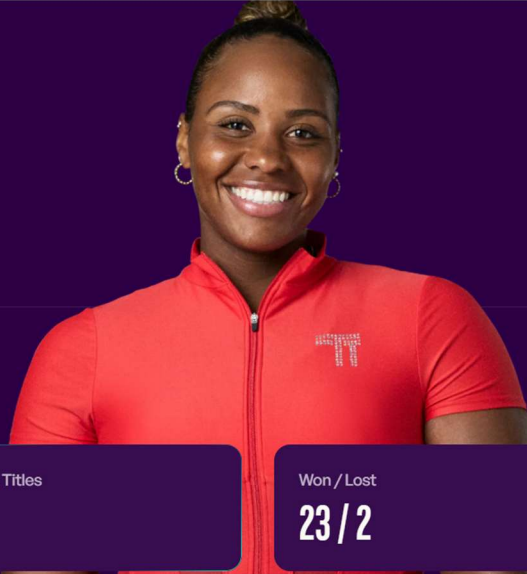
