SINIAKOVA/TOWNSEND QUICK HITS:

- Siniakova/Townsend have now reached their 5th Grand Slam final as a team (3-1 in Grand Slam finals)
- As a duo, they have won Grand Slam titles at 2024 Wimbledon (d. Dabrowski/Routliffe in final), 2025 Australian Open (d. Hsieh/Ostapenko in final) and 2026 Roland Garros (d. Danilina/Krunic in final)
- They are a US Open title away from the Career Grand Slam as a women's doubles team – their prior best US Open result as a team was finishing R-Up here last year (l. Dabrowski/Routliffe in final)
- Seeking their 8th Tour-level title as a team; along with their 3 Grand Slam titles, they have also won 4 WTA 1000 titles together (3 of those coming this year)
- Siniakova and Townsend teamed up for the first time at 2024 Rome (l. Gauff/Routliffe in quarterfinals), and in just their third event together, they won the 2024 Wimbledon title
- Last month, they became the first players to qualify for the 2026 WTA Finals Indian Wells



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SINIAKOVA:

- Currently ranked WTA Doubles World No.1
- Including the weeks of 2026 US Open, has 199 total weeks at WTA Doubles World No.1, which ties her for 2nd-most all-time weeks as Doubles No.1, behind Martina Navratilova (237) and equal w/ Liezel Huber (199)
- She is already an 11-time Grand Slam champion in women's doubles (7 titles with Krejčíková, 3 with Townsend and 1 with Gauff)
- Her one prior US Open women's doubles title came in 2022 w/Barbora Krejčíková – winning that title gave both her and Krejčíková the Career Golden Slam in women's doubles (all four majors plus Olympic gold)
- She is one of 7 women to have completed the Career Golden Slam in women's doubles in the Open Era (also Krejčíková, Serena Williams, Venus Williams, Gigi Fernandez, Pam Shriver, and Sara Errani)
- Has won 38 Tour-level doubles titles in her career overall, including a Tour-leading six titles this year
- In mixed doubles, she won the 2024 Olympic gold medal (w/Machac) and the 2025 Wimbledon title (w/Verbeek)
- Has also won 5 career WTA singles titles and holds a career-high singles ranking of No.27 (June 2024)

TOWNSEND:

- Currently ranked World No.2 in doubles
- Reached World No.1 in doubles for the first time on July 28, 2025; she held the top ranking for a total of eight weeks last summer
- She is already a 3-time Grand Slam champion in women's doubles, all alongside Siniakova (2024 Wimbledon, 2025 Australian Open and 2026 Roland Garros)
- Winning today's title would give her the Career Grand Slam in women's doubles (all four major titles)
- She has previously been a 2-time US Open women's doubles runner-up, in 2022 (w/McNally, I. Krejčíková and her partner today, Siniakova) and 2025 (w/Siniakova, I. Dabrowski/Routliffe)
- She has also been a 2-time mixed doubles Grand Slam runner-up at 2024 US Open (w/Young) and 2025 Roland Garros (w/King)
- Has won 16 Tour-level doubles titles in her career overall, including 5 this year
- In singles, Townsend made her first WTA final this year at Austin (I. Stearns in all-American F); also, she defeated two Top 20 seeds during this very fortnight, making the US Open R16 for 3rd time in her career

KRUEGER/MONTGOMERY QUICK HITS:

- Wild card team is playing their first event together since 2023, and they are now both into their first Grand Slam final after coming back from 8-2 down in the match-tiebreak in their semifinal win
- Five years ago, Krueger and Montgomery teamed up to win the 2021 US Open junior doubles title; Montgomery also won the 2021 US Open junior singles title that same weekend
- They played their first professional event as a team on the World Tennis (formerly ITF) circuit in 2019, and have won two team titles at World Tennis events
- Before this event, their best team results at Tour-level have been QFs at 2021 San Jose and 2023 Austin (at 2021 San Jose, they lost to Dabrowski/Stefani, the team they defeated in this week's semifinals)
- They defeated defending champions Dabrowski and Routliffe en route to this week's final, but in two separate matches – they beat Routliffe (w/Sutjiadi) in the QF and Dabrowski (w/Stefani) in the SF

KRUEGER:

- Contesting her 2nd career doubles final at WTA Tour-level (1-0 record in Tour-level doubles finals)
- Has won 1 career WTA doubles title, teaming up with Sloane Stephens to win on the green clay at 2024 Charleston (d. L.Kichenok/N.Kichenok in F)
- This is her first doubles event since 2026 Roland Garros (w/Kenin, I. Errani/Tagger in 1r)
- Before the US Open, she was 0-3 in doubles matches this year (also lost 1r at Australian Open and Austin)
- Prior to this event, she had never advanced beyond the 2r at a women's doubles Grand Slam event



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- Currently ranked No.610 in doubles; her career-high doubles ranking is No.62 (set on August 12, 2024)
- In singles, she is currently ranked No.60 (career-high No.29), won 1 career WTA title at 2023 Osaka on hard court, and reached her first Grand Slam R16 this summer at 2026 Wimbledon as a qualifier

MONTGOMERY:

- This is her first career doubles final at WTA Tour-level
- Before this week, her best Tour-level results in doubles were three QFs, two with Krueger (2021 San Jose and 2023 Austin) and one with Gauff (2025 Madrid – l. Azarenka and her partner today, Krueger)
- Contesting just her 2nd Tour-level doubles event of the year, following 2026 Madrid (w/Gauff, l. Eikeri/Gleason in 2r)
- Also played two WTA 125 doubles events in 2026 clay season, both w/Osuigwe (0-2 in those events)
- Prior to this fortnight, her best Grand Slam result in women's doubles was R16 at 2023 US Open (as WC w/Ngounoue, l. eventual R-Ups Siegemund/Zvonareva)
- Currently ranked No.570 in doubles; her career-high doubles ranking is No.119 (set on September 11, 2023)
- In singles, she is currently ranked No.187 (career-high No.95) and won her first WTA title this summer on the grass of 's-Hertogenbosch as a qualifier ranked No.484 (lowest-ranked WTA titlist this year)
