RECORD BOOK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

In September 2021, in a ceremony hosted at a WTA Tournament in Portozoz, Katarina Srebotnik was recognized by the Guinness World Records as the first (and youngest) tennis player - men or women - to win their first main draw tournament across all three disciplines - singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Srebotnik won her debut in singles (1999 Oeiras), in doubles (1998 Makarska, w/Krizan) and mixed doubles (1999 Roland Garros, w/Norval)

TIE-BREAK RECORDS

At 1999 Madrid Open in the second round, Emmanuelle Gagliardi defeated Tara Snyder 6–7(19–21), 6–1, 6–1 in the second round. The first-set tie-break stands as the longest tie-break in WTA Tour history.
